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THE TWINS: After completing their six-game, seven-day homestand with a record of 2-4 (0-3 vs. the Dodgers and 2-1 vs. the Rockies), the Twins began their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with a win in Houston last night...tonight, they will play the second of three at Daikin Park against the Astros...after tomorrow night's series finale, Minnesota will travel to New York to spend an off-day on Thursday, then play the Yankees in the Bronx over the weekend.
⚡ The Twins have won three of their last four, nine of their last 14 and 11 of their last 18.

HOUSTON? ZEBBY HAS NO PROBLEM: The Twins beat the Astros last night at Daikin Park by a score of 5-4...Zebby Matthews (4-5) was the starter and winner, allowing one run (Cam Smith homer) on four hits in 7.0 innings pitched, with one walk and seven strikeouts...he retired 13 of his first 14 hitters and 15 of his first 16...the offense recorded eight hits, two from Brooks Lee...Minnesota got home runs from Royce Lewis (8), Victor Caratini (7) and Josh Bell (10).

NOTHING BEATS A MINNESOTA SUMMER: Last night's victory made the Twins 14-12 this month, securing Derek Shelton's first winning month as Twins manager...first winning month for the Twins since going 18-8 in May of 2025...first winning month for Shelly as a manager since his former Pirates went 14-12 in June of 2024.

SPACEBALLS: The Twins and Astros are playing the fifth of six games in 2026...Twins are 3-1 vs. Houston this season, going 2-1 at Target Field (May 18-20) and 1-0 this series.

- ⚡ Brooks Lee is hitting .417 (15-for-36) with one double, one triple, three home runs, seven RBI and a 1.167 OPS in nine career games vs. Houston...he has hit safely in all nine.
- ⚡ Josh Bell is hitting .290 (29-for-100) with seven home runs, 13 RBI and an .895 OPS in 27 career games against the Astros...in four games vs. Houston this season, Bell is 6-for-15 (.400) with three home runs, six RBI and one walk.
- ⚡ In seven career regular season games vs. the Astros, Royce Lewis is hitting .321 (9-for-28)...he has hit safely in six-straight vs. Houston...he has homered three times in his last four games against the 'Stros — all have come at Daikin Park...if you include the 2023 Post-season, Royce has homered five times in his last eight games vs. Houston, four being here.
- ⚡ Twins have gone 7-3 against the AL West this season, including five-straight wins against Texas teams...dating back to September of 2025, the Twins have gone 8-2 against Texas clubs.

SUMMER SLUGGERS: Through 26 games this month, the Twins are slugging .476, which ranks second-best in baseball, trailing only Colorado (.492).

- ⚡ This month, Minnesota ranks fourth in baseball in OPS (.810), trailing Colorado (.845), Milwaukee (.823) and Pittsburgh (.815).
- ⚡ Twins have homered in all but four of their last 23 games since June 4, hitting 42 in that span...since that date, they rank second in baseball in homers, trailing the Athletics (43).

HOTELS AND HANDSHAKES: Since the start of their last road trip that began on June 15, the Twins have gone 6-1 in seven road games...they went 3-0 at Texas (June 15-18), 2-1 at Arizona (June 19-21) and 1-0 in Houston.

- ⚡ In those seven road games, they have hit .314 (83-for-264) with 7.9 runs-per-game...they have outscored opponents 55-30.
- ⚡ Twins have won three-straight road games and are seeking their fourth-straight for the first time since May 9-24, when they won five-straight away from Minnesota.

ROTATIONAL PULL: Over their last 12 games, Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 4-4, 3.21 ERA (67.1 IP, 24 ER) with eight home runs allowed, 20 walks, 64 strikeouts and six quality starts.

- ⚡ Twins starters have walked just one hitter in their last 75 batters faced.
- ⚡ Over their last five starts, they have posted a 7.00 K/BB ratio (35 K/5 BB).

MAJORITY RULES: The Twins are looking to win their 13th series of the season tonight...they have gone 12-14-1 in series play, 7-5-1 at home and 5-9-0 on the road.

- ⚡ Twins have won four of their last five series, taking series from St. Louis (6/12-14), Texas (6/15-18), Arizona (6/19-21) and Colorado (6/26-28)...their only series loss in that span was a sweep by Los Angeles-NL (6/22-24).
- ⚡ Twins seeking their third-straight road series win, which would mark the first time since May 2-18, 2025, when they won three-straight series at Boston, at Baltimore and at Milwaukee, as part of their 13-game winning streak.
- ⚡ Twins are seeking their second-straight series win over the Astros after taking two of three at Target Field from May 18-20...their last series win in Houston came May 31-June 2, 2024, taking two of three...that was also the same year the Twins went undefeated in series play vs. the Astros for a single season.

37 CARAT MAGIC IN THE AIR: In 19 games this month, Victor Caratini is hitting .355 (22-for-62) with four doubles, five home runs, 13 RBI, nine walks, a .438 on-base percentage, a .661 slugging percentage and a 1.100 OPS...among all AL players with a minimum of 70 plate appearances this month, he ranks first in OPS, second in batting average and slugging, and third in on-base percentage.
⚡ By comparison, his slashline in March/April was .221/.312/.273 (.585 OPS) and .143/.261/.214 (.475 OPS) in May.

I GOT A FEVER AND ONLY PRESCRIPTION IS MORE JOSH BELL: In 26 games this month, Josh Bell is hitting .297 (27-for-91) with six doubles, one triple, five home runs, 21 RBI, a .347 on-base percentage, a .549 slugging percentage and an .896 OPS.
⚡ He leads the club with 53 RBI for the season...21 of those RBI have come in his last 22 games.

THERE'S NO KREI-ING IN BASEBALL: Over his last 12 games, Ryan Kreidler is hitting .412 (14-for-34) with one double, one triple, two home runs, 10 RBI, a .444 on-base percentage, a .676 slugging percentage and a 1.121 OPS.
⚡ Kreidler has made starts defensively at shortstop (12), centerfield (10), third base (4) and leftfield (2) this season.
