**THE TWINS:** Completed their seven-game homestand with a record of 3-4, going 2-1 vs. Chicago-AL and 1-3 vs. Kansas City...tonight, the Twins will begin a short three-game series/roadtrip with the first of three vs. the Tigers at Comerica Park.  
 ☞ Twins are 5-2 this season following an off-day...their five wins are March 28 at Baltimore, April 21 at New York-NL, May 5 at Washington, May 12 vs. Miami and May 22 at Boston...their two losses are April 1 at Kansas City and April 17 vs. Cincinnati...following their last day off, they came out with a three-game sweep at Fenway from May 22-24.

**ROYAL DREADING:** The Twins lost to the Royals on Sunday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 6-5 and had their comeback attempt with four ninth-inning runs cut short...Connor Prielipp (2-4) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing two runs on four hits in 4.1 innings pitched with one walk and seven strikeouts...the offense recorded eight hits, two from Kody Clemens, who singled twice...Josh Bell hit his sixth home run of the season, a three-run jimmy jack in the ninth inning, the 199th of his career.

**MOTOR CITY MATCHUP:** The Twins and Tigers are playing the fifth of 13 games tonight...these two last met for four games at Target Field from April 6-9 as the Twins swept...their last trip to Comerica Park came August 4-6, 2025, as the Twins lost game one and won games two and three...they went 3-3 at Detroit last season.

☞ The Twins have won five straight over the Tigers for the first time since April 26-May 24, 2022 (also 5)...last time they won six straight over Detroit was August 13-September 29, 2017 (also 6).  
 ☞ Twins lead baseball in home runs vs. Detroit since the start of 2019, hitting 152, 34 ahead of Cleveland (118)...70 of those have come at Comerica Park...they have homered 30 times in their last 20 games at Comerica and 21 times in their last 12 here.

☞ Over his last 21 games against the Tigers, Byron Buxton has posted a .961 OPS and a .602 slugging percentage, hitting eight doubles and six home runs in 92 plate appearances.  
 ☞ Royce Lewis has posted an .849 OPS in 24 career games vs. the Tigers...he has reached base safely in all 24 career games vs. the Tigers (.409 OBP, 21 H, 17 BB).

☞ Luke Keaschall is hitting .324 (12-for-37) with two doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI, five walks, a .405 on-base percentage and a .945 OPS...in two career games at Comerica, he is 4-for-9 with two doubles, one home run and six RBI.

**SWEEP MEMORIES:** The Twins hosted the Tigers for four games in early April, sweeping the series and outscoring them 22-12...notable numbers from that series:

☞ Josh Bell went 7-for-14 (.500) with one home run and two walks...Victor Caratini went 6-for-16 (.375) with three RBI and one walk...Byron Buxton went 5-for-15 (.333) with two doubles and four walks...Royce Lewis went 4-for-12 (.333) with three RBI and four walks.  
 ☞ Twins pitching staff posted a 2.75 ERA (36.0 IP, 11 ER) with 15 walks, 40 strikeouts (10.0 K/9.0 IP) and a .217 opponent batting average...starters went 3-0, 1.96 ERA (23.0 IP, 5 ER) with seven walks, 25 strikeouts and a .202 opponent batting average...Twins pitchers did not allow a home run over the four games.

**BUCK NASTY:** On Thursday night (6/4), Byron Buxton hit his 18th home run of the season...he has hit all 18 home runs over his last 41 games, since April 13...since that date, he ranks second in baseball in home runs, trailing only Kyle Schwarber (19)...below are Buck's season AL rankings in a few offensive categories:

**INTERSTATES FULL OF BUCK TRUCKS:** Byron Buxton has homered seven times in his last 19 road games...entering this series, he has homered in five of his last seven road series (NYM, WAS, CLE, BOS & CWS; his two misses were the TB and PIT series).

☞ Since June 17, 2025, Buck has hit 24 road home runs, tied for third-most in baseball since that date with Willy Adames, and trailing Junior Caminero (25) and Christian Walker (25).

**KODE OF CONDUCT:** Over his last 25 games, Kody Clemens is hitting .303 (30-for-99) with nine doubles, two triples, five home runs, 11 RBI, 15 runs scored, a .330 on-base percentage, a .586 slugging percentage and a .916 OPS...over that 25-game span, he has started at five different positions defensively: first base 14 times, centerfield five times, rightfield three times, leftfield twice and second base once.

☞ Clemens was selected by the Tigers in the third round (79th overall) of the 2018 MLB Draft...he made his major league debut in this ballpark against the Twins on May 31, 2022...he recorded his first career hit here on June 13, 2022 vs. Chicago-AL, singling off Lance Lynn.

**ROYCE MAKING NOISE:** In 15 games between Minnesota and Triple-A St. Paul from May 21-June 7, Royce Lewis has hit .317 (19-for-60) with four doubles, eight home runs, 19 RBI, a .397 on-base percentage, a .783 slugging percentage and a 1.180 OPS.

☞ In that span defensively, he has started six games at third base, three at first base and two at second base.

**37 CARAT GOLD:** Victor Caratini went 1-for-1 in a pinch-hit appearance on Sunday, extending his season-long hitting streak to eight games, also the longest streak by a Twin this season...marks the second-longest hitting streak of his career; his career-long is 12, from July 7-24, 2025...during the current streak, he is hitting .400 (10-for-25) with three doubles, one home run, six RBI, three walks, a .467 on-base percentage, a .640 slugging percentage and a 1.107 OPS...during the streak, he is 9-for-23 (.391) as a left-handed batter and 1-for-8 (.125) as a right-handed batter.

**BELL POWER:** Josh Bell hit his sixth home run of the season on Sunday and 199th of his career...one more homer and he will become the 40th active player to reach the 200-home run mark; the last to do it was Xander Bogaerts on April 15...over his last 11 games, Bell is hitting .282 (11-for-39) with four doubles, one home run, seven RBI, a .317 on-base percentage, a .462 slugging percentage and a .779 OPS.

**FULL PLATES:** Twins enter today with 308 runs scored, fifth-most in the AL, trailing New York (331), Houston (312), Baltimore (312) and Chicago (310)...they have scored 4.5 runs-per-game (139 runs) on the road, compared to 4.7 at home (169 runs).  
 ☞ Through 67 games last season, the Twins had scored 286 runs, eighth-most in the AL.

- Taj Bradley is slated to make his 12th start of the season and 85th start (87th game) of his career.
- This will be Taj's second career start against the Tigers, with his lone start against Detroit coming on April 7, when he earned the win in 6.1 innings of one-run, six-hit ball, with no walks and a season-high 10 strikeouts.
- In his last outing on June 3 vs. Chicago-AL, Bradley took his second loss of the season, allowing four runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings pitched, with five walks and five strikeouts, as the Twins fell to the White Sox 8-0 at Target Field.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Taj made his 11th start of the season on June 3 vs. Chicago-AL opposite right-hander Erick Fedde...took his second loss of the season, allowing four runs while matching his season-high with seven hits allowed (done one other time on April 24 at Tampa Bay) in 4.2 innings pitched...also matched his career high with five walks (done one other time on September 3, 2023 at Cleveland with Tampa Bay) and five strikeouts, as the Twins suffered their first shutout loss of the season by a score of 8-0 at Target Field.

- The loss was his first at Target Field since September 17, 2025 vs. New York-AL, snapping a streak of three consecutive home starts without a loss, his longest such streak as a Twin.
- In three starts since returning from the Injured List on May 23, Taj is 1-1 with a 5.93 ERA (13.2 IP, 9 ER), nine walks, 18 strikeouts, a 1.76 WHIP and a .283 (15-for-53) BAA.
- Twins starting pitchers have thrown 100-plus pitches 13 times this season, second most in MLB behind Los Angeles-NL (15).

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Taj made his 10th start of the season and second since returning from the Injured List on May 23...did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on five hits - including a solo blast from Oneil Cruz - with two walks and six strikeouts, as the Twins fell to the Pirates 6-5 courtesy of a Bryan Reynolds two-run, walk-off homer in the ninth inning.

- The start marked his first against the Pirates, leaving the San Francisco Giants as the only team Taj has not faced in his major league career.
- The home run to Oneil Cruz was the first surrendered by Bradley since April 29 vs. Seattle, and is just the sixth he has allowed all season, with four of those coming against the Rays on April 24 at Tropicana Field...six home runs are his fewest allowed through his first 10 starts of a season since his debut season in 2023 with Tampa Bay, when he allowed five homers across his first 10 big league starts.

**TIGER KING:** Taj is slated to make his second career start against Detroit, with his lone start against the Tigers coming on April 7, when he outdueled two-time reigning American League Cy Young Award winner Tarik Skubal with 6.1 innings of one-run, six-hit ball, with no walks and a season-high 10 strikeouts, helping the Twins defeat the Tigers 4-2 at Target Field.

- Taj's 10 strikeouts against the Tigers on April 7 are his most in a single game since joining the Twins and are the most by a Twin against Detroit since Bailey Ober struck out 11 Tigers on July 28, 2024.
- He has faced nine Tigers batters (including players on the Injured List); they are hitting a combined .207 (6-for-29) with one double (Zach McKinstry), one walk and 12 strikeouts.

**TAJ AND THE CENTRAL:** In his career, Taj is 4-6 with a 3.83 ERA (94.0 IP, 40 ER), 36 walks, 90 strikeouts, a 1.32 WHIP and .245 (88-for-359) BAA vs. American League Central opponents... he has made eight starts on the road against the American League Central, combining to go 2-2 with a 3.95 ERA (43.1 IP, 19 ER), 17 walks and 36 strikeouts in those contests.

- Taj has made three starts against the AL Central this season (at KC, vs. DET, vs. CWS); he is 2-1 with a 2.65 ERA (17.0 IP, 5 ER), six walks, 18 strikeouts, a 1.41 WHIP and a .265 (18-for-68) BAA.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS (CAREER):** Over the course of his career, Bradley is 12-16 with a 4.91 ERA (218.0 IP, 119 ER), 73 walks, 245 strikeouts and a 1.28 WHIP in 41 career home starts compared to 12-13 with a 4.46 ERA (228.0 IP, 113 ER), 95 walks, 235 strikeouts and a 1.33 WHIP in 45 road appearances (43 starts).

- SO FAR IN 2026:** This year, he owns a 1-1 record with a 3.38 ERA (24.0 IP, 9 ER), nine walks, 27 strikeouts and a 1.29 WHIP in four home starts compared to a 4-1 record with a 3.68 ERA (36.2 IP, 15 ER), 17 walks, 43 strikeouts and a 1.34 WHIP in seven road starts.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** This season, left-handed hitters have slashed .211/.291/.361 (28-for-133) with eight doubles, four home runs, 15 walks and 45 strikeouts against Bradley, while righties are hitting .265/.348/.388 (26-for-98) with six doubles, two home runs, 11 walks and 25 strikeouts.

**THE ARSENAL:** So far this season, Bradley has used a four-pitch mix, here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant.

- DEATH BY A THOUSAND CUTS:** His strikeout percentage of 32.3% with the cutter is the highest by a pitcher in baseball (min. 50 plate appearances)...he also ranks second with the cutter in whiff percentage (36.4) and third in BAA (.182).

**INJURY BUG:** Taj's hot start to his 2026 campaign was interrupted when he was placed on the 15-day Injured List on May 9 (retroactive to May 6) with right pectoralis muscle inflammation...he was reinstated from the 15-day IL on May 23 and has made three starts since, but his numbers have not been up to par with his stats prior to the injury...below is a table displaying his numbers in eight starts prior to his stint on the IL, compared to what he has done in three starts since making his return:

- Prior to being placed on the IL on May 9, Taj ranked 10th in the American League in ERA (2.87), sixth in strikeouts (52), was tied for fifth in both wins (4) and games started (5), and was tied for third in win percentage (.800).
