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THE TWINS: After completing their six-game, seven-day homestand with a record of 2-4 (0-3 vs. the Dodgers and 2-1 vs. the Rockies), the Twins began their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with a split of the first two games in Houston this week...tonight, they will play the three-game series finale at Daikin Park against the Astros...after tonight's game, Minnesota will travel to New York to spend an off-day tomorrow, then play the Yankees in the Bronx over the weekend.
✦ Twins have gone 7-6 in rubber games this season...their seven wins were April 12 at Toronto, May 10 at Cleveland, May 14 vs. Miami, May 20 vs. Houston, June 14 vs. St. Louis, June 21 at Arizona and Sunday vs. Colorado.

RARE UNRAVELING FROM RYAN: The Twins lost to the Astros last night at Daikin Park by a score of 6-4...Joe Ryan (5-5) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing six runs (all in the 4th inning) on six hits, which included a Yordan Alvarez grand slam...Eric Orze and Marco Raya each pitched 2.0 scoreless innings of relief...the offense recorded six hits, two from Kody Clemens...Josh Bell had the only extra-base hit, hitting his 17th double in the fifth inning.

SPACED OUT: The Twins and Astros are playing for the sixth and final time in 2026...Twins are 3-2 vs. Houston this season, going 2-1 at Target Field (May 18-20) and 1-1 this series.
✦ Twins need a win tonight to secure the season-Series over Houston, which would mark the first time since 2024 (4-2)...they went 1-5 vs. the Astros last season.
✦ Brooks Lee is hitting .400 (16-for-40) with one double, one triple, three home runs, seven RBI and a 1.100 OPS in 10 career games vs. Houston...he has hit safely in all 10.
✦ Josh Bell is hitting .288 (30-for-104) with five doubles, seven home runs, 14 RBI and an .889 OPS in 28 career games against the Astros...in five games vs. Houston this season, Bell is 7-for-19 (.368) with three home runs, seven RBI and one walk.
✦ In eight career regular season games vs. the Astros, Royce Lewis is hitting .323 (10-for-31)...he has hit safely in seven-straight vs. Houston...he has homered three times in his last five games against the 'Stros — all have come at Daikin Park...if you include the 2023 Post-season, Royce has homered five times in his last nine games vs. Houston, four being here.
✦ Twins have gone 7-4 against the AL West this season...dating back to September of 2025, the Twins have gone 8-3 against Texas clubs.

FLIGHTS AND FIST BUMPS: Since the start of their last road trip that began on June 15, the Twins have gone 6-2 in eight road games...they went 3-0 at Texas (June 15-18), 2-1 at Arizona (June 19-21) and 1-1 in Houston.
✦ In those eight road games, they have hit .301 (89-for-296) and averaged 7.4 runs-per-game...they have outscored opponents 59-36.

BEST OF: The Twins are looking to win their 13th series of the season tonight...they have gone 12-14-1 in series play, 7-5-1 at home and 5-9-0 on the road.
✦ Twins have won four of their last five series, taking series from St. Louis (6/12-14), Texas (6/15-18), Arizona (6/19-21) and Colorado (6/26-28)...their only series loss in that span was a sweep by Los Angeles-NL (6/22-24).
✦ Twins seeking their third-straight road series win, which would mark the first time since May 2-18, 2025, when they won three-straight series at Boston, at Baltimore and at Milwaukee, as part of their 13-game winning streak.
✦ Twins are seeking their second-straight series win over the Astros after taking two of three at Target Field from May 18-20...their last series win in Houston came May 31-June 2, 2024, taking two of three...that was also the same year the Twins went undefeated in series play vs. the Astros for a single season.

THERE'S NO KREI-ING IN BASEBALL: Over his last 13 games, Ryan Kreidler is hitting .395 (15-for-38) with one double, one triple, two home runs, 12 RBI, a .425 on-base percentage, a .632 slugging percentage and a 1.057 OPS.
✦ Kreidler has made starts defensively at shortstop (12), centerfield (11), third base (4) and leftfield (2) this season.

GIMME A BELL YEAH! In 27 games since June 1, Josh Bell is hitting .295 (28-for-95) with seven doubles, one triple, five home runs, 22 RBI, a .343 on-base percentage, a .547 slugging percentage and an .891 OPS.
✦ He leads the club with 54 RBI for the season...22 of those RBI have come in his last 23 games...he has at least one RBI in 15 of those 23.
✦ Bell has a career-high 15-game road hitting streak (since May 28), hitting .356 (21-for-59) with a 1.031 OPS in that span...it's the longest active road streak in baseball and fifth-longest in baseball this season; Paul Goldschmidt's 20-gamer is the longest...Justin Morneau holds the club record with 34-straight in 2006...Bell's is the longest by a Twin since Brooks Lee's 16-game road streak from May 28-June 28, 2025.

CULPEPPER GETS HIS ROLL ON AGAIN: Twins No. 2 prospect (MLB.com) infielder Kaelen Culpepper has been named to the 2026 All-Star Futures Game for the second consecutive year...Culpepper lined out in his only at-bat in last year's game in Atlanta...the following players have represented the Twins in the Futures Game since 2013: **Luke Keaschall** and **Brooks Lee** in 2024; **David Festa** in 2023; Spencer Steer and **Matt Wallner** in 2022, Josh Winder in 2021; Jordan Balazovic and **Royce Lewis** in 2019; Alex Kiriloff and Lewis Thorpe in 2018; Nick Gordon in 2017; JT Chargois in 2016; José Berrios in 2015 & '14; Max Kepler in 2015; Trevor May, Alex Meyer and Kennys Vargas in 2014; and **Byron Buxton** and Miguel Sanó in 2013...**bold** indicates still in organization.
✦ Other Twins to be selected for other teams: Josh Bell (PIT - 2014 & '15), Taj Bradley (TB - 2022), Victor Caratini (CHC - 2017), Alex Jackson (SEA - 2015), Austin Martin (TOR - 2021) and Eric Orze (NYM - 2021).

TWINS MILB MONTHLYS: Twins have named right-handed pitcher Marco Raya and Low-A Fort Myers infielder/catcher Ryan Sprock as their minor league Pitcher and Player of the Month for June.
✦ Raya, who is currently in the Twins bullpen, pitched in six games (all in relief) for Triple-A St. Paul before being recalled (June 24) and went 1-0, 0.00 ERA (8.0 IP) with four hits allowed, no walks, seven strikeouts, a 0.50 WHIP and a .148 opponent batting average.
✦ Sprock, 21, played in 20 games for the Mighty Mussels, hitting .417 (30-for-72) with seven doubles, one triple, two home runs, 18 RBI, 19 walks, a .543 on-base percentage, a .625 slugging percentage and a 1.168 OPS...the Morristown, NJ native was selected by the Twins in the eighth round of the 2025 MLB Draft out of Elon University.
