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THE TWINS: After completing their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with a record of 4-2 (2-1 in Houston and 2-1 in the Bronx), the Twins began their six-game homestand with a 2-1 series win over the Guardians this week...tonight, they will begin their final series before the All-Star break, hosting the Angels for three games over the weekend.

- ☞ Twins have won four of their last five and seven of their last 10.
- ☞ Twins have won three of their last four home games and four of their last six at Target Field.
- ☞ Twins have a +26 (126-100) run differential in their last 22 games, since June 14.

SWEEP MISSED: The Twins lost to the Guardians yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 5-2...Bailey Ober (right elbow inflammation) returned to the rotation and allowed one run on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts...Woosuk Go made his major league debut, allowing a home run with one strikeout in 1.0 inning of relief...the offense recorded just three hits, walked once and struck out 14 times...Royce Lewis had two of the hits, one being a home run, his ninth of the season.

WINNESOTA: Since June 14, the Twins have gone 14-8, posting a winning percentage of .636, tied for highest in the AL since that date...below are overall MLB rankings since June 14:

CALLING ALL ANGELS: The Twins and Angels are playing tonight for the first of seven games in 2026...Twins went 4-2 vs. the Angels last season, going 3-0 at home from April 25-27 and 1-2 in Anaheim from September 8-10.

- ☞ Minnesota has gone 10-3 in their last 13 against the Angels, dating back to September of 2023...in that span, have a run differential of +42 (97-55).
- ☞ Minnesota's .750 winning percentage (9-3) vs. the Angels since the start of 2024, is their highest against any MLB opponent.
- ☞ Since the start of 2024, the Twins are hitting .301 (126-for-418) vs. Angel pitching, with 53 extra-base hits (17 HR), 7.3 runs-per-game, a .512 slugging percentage and an .893 OPS.
- ☞ Over his last 10 games vs. the Angels, Trevor Larnach is hitting .389 (14-for-36) with nine RBI, eight walks, a .489 on-base percentage and a 1.017 OPS.
- ☞ In his last nine games vs. LAA, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .324 (11-for-34) with three doubles, one triple, two home runs, 12 RBI, a .647 slugging percentage and a 1.052 OPS.

RELY ON JEFFERS: The Twins have returned catcher Ryan Jeffers from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List...Jeffers, who missed the club's last 46 games with a left hamate bone fracture, recently played in five games for Triple-A St. Paul on rehab assignment, hitting .375 (6-for-16) with one double, two home runs, two RBI and two walks.

- ☞ To make room for Jeffers on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned outfielder Kyler Fedko to St. Paul...Fedko went 0-for-16 with one RBI and two walks in 14 games.

HELLO, FRIENDS: The Twins have acquired right-handed pitcher Tommy Nance and international bonus pool money from the Toronto Blue Jays, in exchange for minor league catcher/infielder Ryan Sprock...Nance, 35, has appeared in 32 games for the Blue Jays this season, going 1-2, 3.82 ERA (33.0 IP, 14 ER), 13 walks, 34 strikeouts and a .234 opponent batting average, while ranking in MLB's 95th percentile in chase percentage (36.4%) and 88th percentile in breaking run value (5)...since June 18, he has appeared in eight games for Toronto, posting a 2.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 2 ER) with three walks, seven strikeouts and a .206 opponent batting average...the 6-foot-6, 235-pound righty has held right-handed hitters to a slashline of .159/.205/.261 (.466 OPS) with just three extra-base hits...the Long Beach, California native has pitched in parts of five major league seasons with the Cubs (21), Marlins (22) and Blue Jays (2024-26).

- ☞ Sprock, 21, was selected by the Twins in the eighth round of the 2025 First-Year Player Draft out of Elon University and has played in 90 minor league games for Minnesota.
- ☞ To make room for Nance on the 40-man roster, the Twins have transferred right-handed pitcher Mick Abel (right elbow inflammation) to the 60-day Injured List.

HEY JOHN SCHNEIDER...(COUGH, COUGH) LOOK OVER HERE!: Kody Clemens has 16 home runs, three shy of his single-season career-high of 19, set last season...he has homered in five of his last 12 games, but is in a four-game (21 plate appearances) homer drought...he is one homer away from 50 for his career.

- ☞ Since June 1, he's homered 10 times, tied with Nick Kurtz for third-most in the AL since that date, trailing Caminero (14) and Rice (11).
- ☞ Among AL players with at least 300 plate appearances on the season, he ranks seventh in slugging percentage (.500)...also has an .817 OPS, making him one of 20 AL players with an OPS of over .800.
- ☞ Kody is ninth in the AL and 17th in all of baseball (min. 1,000 pitches) in average exit velocity (92.8 mph)...first on the Twins.
- ☞ Clemens has 10 RBI in his last seven games and 15 RBI in his last 12 games.

SUMMER MOUNDNESS: Over their last 20 games, since June 16, Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 7-6, 3.06 ERA (109.0 IP, 37 ER) with 36 walks, 117 strikeouts and eight quality starts...since that date, they rank fifth in the AL in ERA...they have not allowed more than four runs in any of those starts and have allowed two runs-or-fewer in 13 of those.

LIKE SANDS THROUGH THE HOUR GLASS: Cole Sands restarted his rehab assignment and appeared yesterday for Triple-A St. Paul, pitching 1.0 perfect inning at Iowa, throwing 12 pitches...he was placed on the 15-day IL on May 2 with a right forearm strain.

FEELING A DRAFT: The MLB Draft will begin tomorrow at 12:00 pm (CT) as the Twins will select third overall after the White Sox at one and the Rays at two...rounds 1-4 will take place tomorrow, while rounds 5-20 will begin on Sunday at 10:30 am (CT)...tomorrow, the Twins will not only select at third overall, they will also select 43rd overall (2nd round), 74th overall (Competitive Balance Round B), 79th overall (3rd round), 107th overall (4th round) and 139th overall (5th round)...three is the highest pick for the Twins since selecting Royce Lewis with the number one pick in 2017...this will be the third time in club history to select at three, the previous two times being 1987 (RHP Willie Banks) and 1991 (1B David McCarty).

SAY YOUR PRAYERS AND EAT YOUR VITAMINS, BROTHER!: For the first time ever, Major League Baseball and All Elite Wrestling (AEW) are teaming up for "Brawl in the Ballpark," a high-octane postgame event following tonight's game...featuring stars from AEW and Ring of Honor (ROH), the Brawl — which is free to attend with a ticket to the game — is slated to begin 10-15 minutes after the game ends and will take place in a specially-built ring on the Gate 34 lawn area inside Target Field, near the rightfield plaza.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2024, the Twins played a doubleheader against the White Sox at Rate Field, homering in both games to extend their club record to 28-straight games with a homer...the final two homers of the streak in game two were back-to-back by Brooks Lee and Carlos Correa in the sixth inning...Twins went homerless in their next game against the Giants on July 12, snapping the streak...in 2007, Justin Morneau, Torii Hunter and Johan Santana represented the Twins in the All-Star Game in San Francisco.
