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THE TWINS: Have gone 2-2 through four games on their six-game homestand, going 2-1 against Cleveland, followed by a loss to Los Angeles-AL last night...today, Minnesota will continue the homestand with the second of three against the Angels...they will play the series finale tomorrow afternoon and complete the "first half" of the season...after the break, they will begin a seven-game roadtrip with three against the Cubs at Wrigley Field (July 17-19) and four against the Guardians at Progressive Field (July 20-23).

ANGELS PLAY THE HEAL: The Twins lost to the Angels last night at Target Field by a score of 4-3...Zebby Matthews (4-6) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing four runs on nine hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and three strikeouts...Andrew Morris (2.0) and Travis Adams (1.0) combined to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings of relief with no walks and three strikeouts...the offense recorded nine hits as Trevor Larnach, Josh Bell and Brooks Lee all had two doubles apiece...Ryan Jeffers went 1-for-4 with a walk and a double in his return from the IL.

I CAN SEE YOUR HALO: The Twins and Angels are playing today for the second of seven games in 2026...these two will meet in Anaheim for four games from September 17-20, the first leg of the club's final roadtrip of 2026.

✎ Minnesota has gone 10-4 in their last 14 against the Angels, dating back to September of 2023...in that span, have a run differential of +41 (100-59).

✎ Minnesota's .692 winning percentage (9-4) vs. the Angels since the start of 2024 is their highest against any MLB opponent.

✎ Over his last 11 games vs. the Angels, Trevor Larnach is hitting .400 (16-for-40) with nine RBI, nine walks, a .500 on-base percentage and a 1.075 OPS.

✎ In his last 10 games vs. LAA, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .316 (12-for-38) with four doubles, one triple, two home runs, 12 RBI, a .632 slugging percentage and a 1.036 OPS.

HELLO, FRIENDS, TOMMY NANCE HERE: The Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Eric Orze to Triple-A St. Paul...Orze appeared in a career-high 36 games this season, going 2-2, 5.66 ERA (41.1 IP, 26 ER), one home run allowed, 21 walks, 36 strikeouts, one save and eight holds.

✎ To replace Orze on the 26-man roster, the Twins will activate right-handed pitcher Tommy Nance, who was acquired in a trade with the Blue Jays yesterday.

BEST OF: A win today and tomorrow and the Twins will earn their 16th series victory of the season...they have gone 15-14-1 in series play, 8-5-1 at home and 7-9-0 on the road.

✎ Twins have won seven of their last eight series, taking series from St. Louis (6/12-14), Texas (6/15-18), Arizona (6/19-21), Colorado (6/26-28), Houston (6/29-7/1), New York-AL (7/3-5) and Cleveland (July 7-9)...their only series loss in that span was a sweep by Los Angeles-NL (6/22-24).

✎ Twins are seeking their fifth-straight series win, which would mark their longest since winning five-straight from May 2-18, 2025, which was part of their 13-game winning streak.

✎ Twins last series win over the Angels was April 25-27, 2025, sweeping in three games at Target Field...they have won four of their last five series vs. Anaheim, dating back to 2023.

LARNING TO FLY: Over his last 20 games, since June 14, Trevor Larnach is hitting .370 (27-for-73) with eight doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI, a .425 on-base percentage, a .603 slugging percentage and a 1.028 OPS.

✎ Since the start of June, he is hitting .330 (33-for-100) with 10 doubles, three home runs, 14 RBI, 11 walks and a .922 OPS in 30 games...his batting average is the third-best in the AL among players with at least 110 plate appearances since June 1.

✎ Larnach is leading off today for the 18th time in the club's last 21 games...from the number one spot in the lineup, he is hitting .337 (28-for-83) with a .396 on-base percentage, a .542 slugging percentage and a .938 OPS...his batting average from the leadoff spot ranks third-highest in baseball (minimum of 90 PA), trailing Pete Crow-Armstrong (.366) and Yandy Diaz (.345).

JUST SO FRESH, SO C-LEE-N: Brooks Lee hit his 15th double of the season last night, matching his single-season career-high, done last season — 91 games this season, 139 last season...he also now has at least one RBI in four of his last five games...over his last 14 games, he is hitting .327 (18-for-55) with four doubles, one home run, six RBI, seven runs scored, a .393 on-base and an .848 OPS.

A LEFT-HANDED TOAST: In a special pregame ceremony today, former TV broadcaster and current special assistant Dick Bremer will be the 42nd person elected to the Twins Hall of Fame...born in St. Paul and raised in Dumont, Minnesota, Bremer began his Twins play-by-play career with Spectrum Sports from 1983-85...after a one-year hiatus, he rejoined the club's broadcast team in 1987 and was the Twins' television play-by-play voice through the 2023 season...in 2013, he received the Silver Circle Emmy for Broadcast Excellence and was inducted into the Minnesota Museum of Broadcasting Hall of Fame...in 2020, Bremer authored his best-selling memoir, Game Used, recounting his childhood in Dumont and the life lessons he learned across his storied career.

✎ Following the 2023 season, his 40th in the booth, Bremer transitioned into a special assistant role with the Twins, continuing as an ambassador of Twins baseball and as a valued storytelling voice in the community and among generations of Twins fans...he also received the Herb Carneal Lifetime Achievement Award in 2023...Bremer is the longest-tenured television broadcaster for a single team in Major League Baseball history, as well as the longest-tenured broadcaster in Twins history...in 2024, the home television booth inside the Herb Carneal Press Box at Target Field was formally named in Bremer's honor.

✎ The Twins are 18-10 all-time on Twins Hall of Fame induction days.

WHAT'S IT GONNA BE: The MLB Draft will begin today at 12:00 pm (CT) as the Twins will select third overall after the White Sox at one and the Rays at two...rounds 1-4 will take place today, while rounds 5-20 will begin tomorrow at 10:30 am (CT)...the Twins will not only select at third overall today, they will also select 43rd overall (2nd round), 74th overall (Competitive Balance Round B), 79th overall (3rd round), 107th overall (4th round) and 139th overall (5th round)...three is the highest pick for the Twins since selecting Royce Lewis with the number one pick in 2017...this will be the third time in club history to select at three, the previous two times being 1987 (RHP Willie Banks) and 1991 (1B David McCarty).
