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THE TWINS: Have gone 3-2 through five games on their six-game homestand, going 2-1 against Cleveland, followed by a 1-1 split of the first two games against Los Angeles-AL... today, Minnesota will continue the homestand with the three-game series finale against the Angels which will complete the "first half" of the season...after the break, they will begin a seven-game roadtrip with three against the Cubs at Wrigley Field (next weekend) and four against the Guardians at Progressive Field (July 20-23)

☞ Twins have gone 9-6 in rubber games, winning each of their last five instances: June 14 vs. St. Louis, June 21 at Arizona, June 28 vs. Colorado, July 1 at Houston and July 5 at New York-AL.

A LEFT-HANDED TOAST FOR A TWINS WIN: The Twins beat the Angels yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 5-3, evening the three-game series and snapping a three-game losing streak to the Halos...Joe Ryan was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and six strikeouts...Yoendrys Gómez earned his 10th save (10th chance) as a Twin with a scoreless ninth inning...the offense recorded nine hits, two from Royce Lewis, who hit his 10th home run of the season and 11th double.

ANTHEM OF THE ANGELS: The Twins and Angels are playing today for the third of seven games in 2026...these two will meet in Anaheim for four games from September 17-20, the first leg of the club's final roadtrip of 2026.

☞ Minnesota has gone 11-4 in its last 15 against the Angels, dating back to September of 2023...in that span, have a run differential of +43 (105-62).

☞ Minnesota's .714 winning percentage (10-4) vs. the Angels since the start of 2024 is their highest against any MLB opponent.

☞ Over his last 12 games vs. the Angels, Trevor Larnach is hitting .395 (17-for-43) with nine RBI, nine walks, a .491 on-base percentage and a 1.049 OPS.

☞ In his last 10 games vs. LAA, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .316 (12-for-38) with four doubles, one triple, two home runs, 12 RBI, a .632 slugging percentage and a 1.036 OPS.

NORTH STARS: Twins will send outfielder Byron Buxton, right-handed pitcher Joe Ryan and manager Derek Shelton to the 96th All-Star Game in Philadelphia this week.

☞ Buxton, who will miss the game (IL - right hip strain) was voted in by the fans, receiving 1,106,264 votes, third-most among AL outfielders (Judge - 1,788,499 & Trout - 1,735,051)... Buck started in place of Trout in the 2022 All-Star Game in LA and played in the Game and Home Run Derby last season in Atlanta.

☞ Ryan was voted in by his peers and will be making his second appearance in the ASG...he pitched 1.0 scoreless inning last season in Atlanta, striking out two batters.

☞ Shelly will be making his second appearance as an honorary coach for Toronto's John Schneider after serving in that same role in Seattle in 2023 for Rob Thomson's NL squad.

BEST OF: A win today and the Twins will earn their 16th series victory of the season...they have gone 15-14-1 in series play, 8-5-1 at home and 7-9-0 on the road.

☞ Twins have won seven of their last eight series, taking series from St. Louis (6/12-14), Texas (6/15-18), Arizona (6/19-21), Colorado (6/26-28), Houston (6/29-7/1), New York-AL (7/3-5) and Cleveland (July 7-9)...their only series loss in that span was a sweep by Los Angeles-NL (6/22-24).

☞ Twins are seeking their fifth-straight series win, which would mark their longest since winning five-straight from May 2-18, 2025, which was part of their 13-game winning streak.

☞ Twins last series win over the Angels was April 25-27, 2025, sweeping in three games at Target Field...they have won four of their last five series vs. Anaheim, dating back to 2023.

CAPTAIN AMERICA: The 27th All-Star Futures Game will be played today at Philadelphia's Citizens Bank Park at 11 am (CT)...the Twins lone representative for the AL squad is Triple-A St. Paul outfielder Walker Jenkins, making his first career appearance...Jenkins is the 14th ranked prospect in baseball by MLB.com and Minnesota's number one...he replaces infielder Kaelen Culpepper (IL - left hip strain).

"THERE'S A BIG LEAGUER IN EVERY ROUND, TERRY": The MLB Draft will continue today at 10:30 am (CT) with rounds 5-20...the Twins made six selections yesterday, picking Georgia Tech catcher Vahn Lackey third overall, University of Texas catcher Carson Tinny 43rd overall (2nd round), Virginia Tech RHP Brett Renfrow 74th overall (Competitive Balance Round B), Grandview (CO) High School RHP Ethan Wachsmann 79th overall (3rd round) and Texas Christian RHP Tommy LaPour 107th overall (4th round).

☞ The 6-foot-2, 202-pound Lackey hit .397 (87-for-219) with 16 doubles, three triples, 20 home runs, 78 RBI, 81 runs scored, 169 total bases, 50 walks, 85 runs batted in, a .519 on-base percentage, a .772 slugging percentage and a 1.291 OPS in 61 games for the Yellow Jackets in the 2025-26 season, and his 4.88 defensive WAR led the Atlantic Coast Conference and ranked fourth in the country...the 21-year-old was named First-Team All-ACC, and the ACC Defensive Player of the Year after posting a .993 fielding percentage in his 61 games...he was also a finalist for the 2026 Golden Spikes Award...the Suwanee, GA native hit .347 (182-for-525) with 32 doubles, four triples, 30 home runs, 135 RBI, 312 total bases, 87 walks, 144 runs scored, a .450 on-base percentage, a .594 slugging percentage and a 1.045 OPS in 157 games across three seasons for Georgia Tech...Lackey was named to the USA Baseball Collegiate National Team in 2025, was a 2025 Buster Posey Award semifinalist and named to the 2025 All-ACC Second Team.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: Double-A Wichita infielder Marek Houston and outfielder Caden Kendle have been named Twins Co-Players of the Week, and Wichita right-handed pitcher Ruddy Gomez has been named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week.

☞ Houston, 22, appeared in six games for the Wind Surge this week, going 8-for-26 (.308) with one double, one triple, one home run and seven RBI, including falling a double short of the cycle on Tuesday vs. Northwest Arkansas.

☞ Kendle, 24, played in four games for the Surge, going 9-for-16 (.563) with one double, one home run, six RBI and four walks...he was promoted to Wichita and homered in his first game on Tuesday vs. Northwest Arkansas.

☞ Gomez, 26, appeared in two games, striking out five of his nine batters faced and walking one in 4.0 total innings pitched for the Wind Surge.
