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THE TWINS: Have come out of the All-Star break with a record of 1-4, going 1-2 in Chicago against the Cubs last weekend, followed by consecutive losses in Cleveland to the Guardians... tonight, they will continue the trip with the third of four at Progressive Field...after tomorrow afternoon's series finale, Minnesota will travel home to begin a six-game, seven-day homestand with three against the Athletics (this weekend), an off-day on Monday, then three against the Royals (July 28-30).
✦ Twins are looking to avoid dropping five-straight games for the first time since May 27-31, when they lost two to the White Sox, followed by three to the Pirates...five-straight is their season-long, done twice this season.
✦ Twins are looking to snap a four-game road losing streak after going 10-3 in a 13-game stretch away from Target Field, from June 15-July 17.

TWINS CONTINUE POST-ASG SLIDE: The Twins lost to the Guardians last night in Cleveland by a score of 5-2...Kendry Rojas started the game and allowed two runs on one hit in 2.1 innings pitched...Mike Paredes (0-3) "piggy backed" Rojas and was issued the loss, allowing two runs on six hits in 3.0 innings pitched...Jack Anderson made his Twins debut with 1.1 perfect innings of relief...the offense recorded six hits and walked just once...Kody Clemens had two hits, while Ryan Jeffers hit his ninth home run of the season.

GUARD PLAY: The Twins and Guardians are playing the ninth of 13 meetings today...Twins are 4-4 vs. the Guards this season, going 2-3 at Cleveland and 2-1 at Target Field.
✦ Since the start of 2024, 20 of the 34 games between these two have been decided by two runs-or-fewer (Twins 7-13 in those)...and 14 have been decided by one run (Twins 5-9)...at Progressive Field alone, nine of the last 11 here have been decided by two runs-or-fewer (Twins 3-6).
✦ Twins have just four homers against Cleveland pitching this season: Buxton off Festa (5/8 at CLE), Buxton off Bibee (5/9 at CLE), Lewis off Williams (7/9 at MIN) and Jeffers off Messick (Tuesday night).
✦ Over his last eight games vs. the Guards, Brooks Lee is hitting .333 (11-for-33) with six RBI.
✦ In his last 16 games vs. Cleveland, Kody Clemens is hitting .328 (19-for-58) with six doubles, two triples, a .500 slugging percentage and an .850 OPS.
✦ In his last seven games against Cleveland, Byron Buxton is hitting .407 (11-for-27) with three doubles, two home runs, four RBI, three walks, a .741 slugging percentage and a 1.207 OPS...Buxton has reached base safely in nine-straight games at Progressive Field, hitting .368 (14-for-38) with two doubles, two home runs, six RBI and a .979 OPS in that span...has multiple hits in four of his last six games in this ballpark.
✦ In his last 16 games at Progressive Field, Josh Bell is hitting .339 (20-for-59) with five doubles, one triple, three home runs, 10 RBI and a .981 OPS.
✦ Royce Lewis has reached safely in 10-straight games at Progressive Field.

✦ He has 60 RBI on the season, tied for 12th-most in the AL.
✦ Bell is three RBI from matching his 2025 total of 63, which he reached in 140 games.
✦ He is on pace to record 95 RBI, which would be the second-most of his career (116 - 2019).
✦ Since September 7, 2025, Bell has recorded 78 RBI, tied for sixth-most in baseball since that date.
✦ Bell's reached base in eight-straight games (.344 OBP)...he has five doubles in that span.

TOP JEFF: Ryan Jeffers has reached base safely in 15-straight games, one short of his career-high of 16, done April 22-May 9, 2024...over those 15 games, he is hitting .294 (15-for-51) with six doubles, five home runs, 11 RBI, 10 walks, a .410 on-base percentage, a .706 slugging percentage and a 1.116 OPS.
✦ 15-straight games reaching base is the third-longest streak for a Twin this season, trailing Trevor Larnach (18, 4/9-5/5) and Austin Martin (16, 4/4-28).

BUCK NASTY: Over his last 24 games, Byron Buxton is hitting .326 (30-for-92) with six doubles, eight home runs, 18 RBI, 17 runs scored, six walks, a .370 on-base percentage, a .652 slugging percentage and a 1.022 OPS.
✦ He is seeking his first home run since June 22 vs. Los Angeles-NL, a leadoff shot off Will Klein in a 2-1 loss...his current nine-game homer drought is his second-longest of the season; his long is 14 games to begin the season (March 26-April 11)...39 plate appearances since that June 22 homer.
✦ He enters today with a seven-game hitting streak on the road.

THE MISSILE: Kody Clemens has a .556 slugging percentage and an .835 OPS over his last 16 games...in that span, he has 16 hits, eight being extra-base hits (2 2B, 1 3B, 5 HR).
✦ He has 18 home runs, one shy of his single-season career high of 19, set last year...seven of his home runs have come in his last 20 games.
✦ Since June 1, he's homered 12 times, tied with Ben Rice for third-most in baseball, trailing Junior Caminero (16) and Yordan Alvarez (13).
✦ Among AL players with at least 350 plate appearances on the season, he ranks ninth in slugging percentage (.484).
