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DID BUCK HOMER RECENTLY?

—YES— *NO, PROBABLY TODAY, HE'S DUE*

THE TWINS: Have come out of the All-Star break with a record of 2-4, going 1-2 in Chicago against the Cubs last weekend, followed by going 1-2 in Cleveland against the Guardians this week...today, they will complete the trip with the four-game series finale at Progressive Field...after the game, Minnesota will travel home to begin a six-game, seven-day homestand with three against the Athletics (this weekend), an off-day on Monday, then three against the Royals (July 28-30).

Despite the 2-4 record this trip, the Twins have gone 18-13 since June 14, fourth-most wins in the AL and tied for seventh-most in baseball.

Twins have gone 1-2-1 in four-game series this season, going 4-0 vs. Detroit (April 6-9), 2-2 vs. Toronto (April 30-May 3), 1-3 at Chicago-AL (May 25-28) and 1-3 vs. Kansas City (June 4-7).

NEEDED THAT: The Twins beat the Guardians last night at Progressive Field by a score of 10-6, snapping their four-game losing streak...Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on eight hits in 4.0 innings pitched...Travis Adams (2-0) was given the win, pitching 2.0 scoreless innings of relief...the offense recorded 11 hits as Trevor Larnach and Alex Jackson each reached three times, both going 2-for-4 with a walk...Larnach hit his eighth home run (leadoff) and Brooks Lee hit his 15th home run (3-run).

10 runs scored marked Minnesota's most since scoring 11 on July 4 at New York-AL...they came out of the All-Star break having scored 14 runs in five games prior to last night.

TWINS-GUARDIANS: The Twins and Guardians are playing the 10th of 13 meetings today...these two teams will meet for a final series from September 11-13 at Target Field.

Since the start of 2024, 20 of the 35 games between these two have been decided by two runs-or-fewer (Twins 7-13 in those)...and 14 have been decided by one run (Twins 5-9)...at Progressive Field alone, nine of the last 12 here have been decided by two runs-or-fewer (Twins 3-6).

Since 2019, the Twins have hit 79 home runs at Progressive Field, their second-most at any opposing ballpark, trailing Rate Field (98)...also in that span, no opponent has homered more in this ballpark (next: Royals with 60).

Over his last nine games vs. the Guards, Brooks Lee is hitting .342 (13-for-38) with 10 RBI.

In his last 17 games vs. Cleveland, Kody Clemens is hitting .317 (20-for-63) with seven doubles, two triples, a .492 slugging percentage and an .831 OPS.

In his last seven games against Cleveland, Byron Buxton is hitting .407 (11-for-27) with three doubles, two home runs, four RBI, three walks, a .741 slugging percentage and a 1.207 OPS...Buxton has reached base safely in nine-straight games at Progressive Field, hitting .368 (14-for-38) with two doubles, two home runs, six RBI and a .979 OPS in that span...has multiple hits in four of his last six games in this ballpark.

In his last 17 games at Progressive Field, Josh Bell is hitting .328 (21-for-64) with five doubles, one triple, three home runs, 12 RBI and a .936 OPS.

Royce Lewis has reached safely in 11-straight games at Progressive Field.

LOVE FOR THE LAND: Twins are 5-4 vs. the Guards this season, going 3-3 at Cleveland and 2-1 at Target Field...five wins already surpasses Minnesota's 2025 total (4-9)...below are the Twins recent season records vs. Cleveland and at Progressive Field:

TOP JEFF: Ryan Jeffers has reached base safely in 15-straight games, one short of his career-high of 16, done April 22-May 9, 2024...over those 15 games, he is hitting .294 (15-for-51) with six doubles, five home runs, 11 RBI, 10 walks, a .410 on-base percentage, a .706 slugging percentage and a 1.116 OPS.

15-straight games reaching base is the third-longest streak for a Twin this season, trailing Trevor Larnach (18, 4/9-5/5) and Austin Martin (16, 4/4-28).

Over his last seven road games, Jeffers is hitting .320 (8-for-25) with three doubles, three home runs, six RBI, four walks, a .414 on-base, an .800 slugging and a 1.214 OPS.

BELL POWER: Josh Bell has hit safely in all six games on this trip...below are Bell's number comparisons from Opening Day through May 31 and since June 1:

He has 62 RBI on the season, tied for eighth-most in the AL.

Bell is one RBI from matching his 2025 total of 63, which he reached in 140 games.

He is on pace to record 97 RBI, which would be the second-most of his career (116 - 2019).

Since September 7, 2025, Bell has recorded 80 RBI, tied for fourth-most in baseball since that date.

Bell has reached base in nine-straight games (.344 OBP)...he has five doubles in that span.

DAYS GONE BY-RON: Over his last 24 games, Byron Buxton is hitting .326 (30-for-92) with six doubles, eight home runs, 18 RBI, 17 runs scored, six walks, a .370 on-base per centage, a .652 slugging percentage and a 1.022 OPS.

He is seeking his first home run since June 22 vs. Los Angeles-NL, a leadoff shot off Will Klein in a 2-1 loss...his current nine-game homer drought is his second-longest of the season; his long is 14 games to begin the season (March 26-April 11)...39 plate appearances since that June 22 homer.

He enters today with a seven-game hitting streak on the road.
