THE TWINS: Completed their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 3-4, going 1-2 at Wrigley Field last weekend and 2-2 at Progressive Field this week...tonight, they will begin a six-game, seven-day homestand with the first of three against the Athletics through the weekend...they will enjoy an off-day on Monday, then host the Royals for three games from Tuesday-Thursday. **☞** Twins enter this series having gone 7-2-1 in series play since mid-June.

STOP ME IF YOU'VE HEARD THIS, TWINS GO INTO EXTRAS IN CLEVELAND AND.....: The Twins beat the Guardians yesterday afternoon at Progressive Field by a score of 3-1 in 12 innings, making them 4-2 in extras this season...the pitching staff allowed three hits, second time this season they have allowed less than four hits in an extra-inning game, the other being May 9 at Cleveland (2 hits)...Taj Bradley was the starter, allowing one run on two hits in 7.0 innings pitched...five relievers combined to pitch 5.0 scoreless innings of relief as Jack Anderson earned his first career save...the offense recorded six hits, all singles...Trevor Larnach, Luke Keaschall and Alan Roden all drove in a run apiece...additionally, Twins pitchers held the Guards 0-for-17 with runners in scoring position.

STRAIGHT A'S: The Twins and A's are playing for the first of six times this season...Twins went 3-4 last season, going 3-1 in Sacramento from June 2-5 and 0-3 at Target Field from August 19-21...they lost the season-series for the first time since 2021.

☞ Twins are 9-5 in their last 14 against the A's, 15-6 in their last 21 and 19-7 in their last 26, dating back to May of 2022.

☞ In 16 career games against the A's, Trevor Larnach is hitting .311 (19-for-61) with three doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, four walks and an .813 OPS.

☞ Royce Lewis has hit safely in 14 of 17 career games against the A's...in those 17, he is hitting .300 (18-for-60) with six doubles, four home runs, eight RBI, a .600 slug and a .964 OPS.

☞ Ryan Jeffers has reached safely in eight-straight against the A's, posting a .417 on-base with five walks, nine hits and a .950 OPS in that span.

☞ In seven career games against the A's, Brooks Lee is hitting .333 (9-for-27) with two doubles, one home run, six RBI and a .919 OPS.

MAKING A TARGET RUN: Twins return home where they have gone 26-25, winning five of their last seven at Target Field...they have gone 4-1-0 in series play at home since June 12.

☞ Over their last nine home games, Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 2-2, 3.31 ERA (54.1 IP, 20 ER) with five quality starts, 12 walks, 55 strikeouts and a .234 opponent batting average.

☞ Ryan Jeffers has reached base safely in eight-straight home games, while Royce Lewis has reached base safely in seven-straight at home.

☞ In his last 15 home games, Lewis is hitting .304 (17-for-54) with a .934 OPS.

CASE OF THE RUNS: Twins enter today leading the AL in runs scored at 498, in front of Chicago (483), New York (480), Houston (473) and Baltimore (472).

☞ Twins are playing in their 105th game today...through 104 games last season, they had scored 438 runs...they did not reach 500 runs scored until August 13.

AMERICA'S NEXT TOP JEFF: Ryan Jeffers has reached base safely in 16-straight games, matching his career-high, previously done April 22-May 9, 2024...over those 16 games, he is hitting .286 (16-for-56) with six doubles, five home runs, 11 RBI, 10 walks, a .394 on-base percentage, a .661 slugging percentage and a 1.055 OPS.

☞ 16-straight games reaching base is tied for second-longest streak for a Twin this season (Austin Martin - 16, 4/4-28), trailing Trevor Larnach (18, 4/9-5/5).

DAYS GONE BY-RON: Over his last 25 games, Byron Buxton is hitting .323 (31-for-96) with six doubles, eight home runs, 18 RBI, 17 runs scored, seven walks, a .371 on-base percentage, a .635 slugging percentage and a 1.007 OPS.

☞ He is seeking his first home run since June 22 vs. Los Angeles-NL, a leadoff shot off Will Klein in a 2-1 loss...his current 10-game homer drought is his second-longest of the season; his long is 14 games to begin the season (March 26-April 11)...39 plate appearances since that June 22 homer.

☞ Over his last 24 home games, Buck is hitting .313 (30-for-96) with eight doubles, 10 home runs, 14 RBI, a .708 slugging percentage and a 1.074 OPS.
