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THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 3-4 (1-2 at Wrigley Field and 2-2 at Progressive Field), the Twins began their six-game, seven-day homestand with a 1-1 split against the A's this weekend...today, they will play the three-game series finale against the Athletics...they will enjoy an off-day tomorrow, then host the Royals for three games from Tuesday-Thursday.
☞ Twins have gone 10-7 in rubber games this season...they lost their last rubber game on July 19 at Chicago-NL...their last rubber game win was on July 12 vs. Los Angeles-AL.

ROJAS AND RODEN - IF YOU KNOW YOU KNOW: The Twins shut out the Athletics last night by a score of 2-0 at Target Field, Minnesota's third shutout of the season — all at home...Kendry Rojas was the starter, pitching 4.0 shutout innings, with one hit allowed, one walk and five strikeouts...Mike Paredes was scheduled to start but was pulled last minute with a a strain left oblique, something he felt during his warm-up...the bullpen combined for 5.0 shutout innings, with just two hits allowed...the offense recorded six hits, two from Victor Caratini...Alan Roden drove in both runs with a two-out single in the sixth inning.

LET'S HIT THE WATER SLIDES AT THE DELLS! BIG CHEESE IS BACK! The Twins have returned left-handed pitcher Connor Prielipp and right-handed pitcher Cole Sands from their rehab assignments and reinstated them from the 15-day Injured List.
☞ Prielipp, who was placed on the Injured List on July 9 with a left middle finger blister, made one start on rehab assignment for Triple-A St. Paul last Sunday vs. Louisville, pitching 3.0 scoreless innings, with no hits allowed, one walk and three strikeouts, throwing 32 pitches.
☞ Sands, who was placed on the Injured List on May 2 with a right forearm strain, made six appearances on his most recent rehab stint, pitching 7.0 scoreless innings with eight strikeouts between the Florida Complex League Twins and Triple-A St. Paul.
☞ To make room for Prielipp and Sands on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Jack Anderson to St. Paul and placed right-handed pitcher Mike Paredes on the 15-day Injured List with a left oblique strain.

TWINS AND A's: The Twins and A's are playing for the third of six times this season...these two teams will meet again in Sacramento for three games from August 24-26.

☞ Twins are 10-6 in their last 16 against the A's, 16-7 in their last 23 and 20-8 in their last 28, dating back to May of 2022.
☞ Ryan Jeffers has reached safely in nine-straight against the A's, posting a .400 on-base with five walks, 10 hits and a .900 OPS in that span.

TWINS TRY TO MEATLOAF THE ATHLETICS: A win today and the Twins will earn their 17th series victory of the season...they have gone 16-15-2 in series play, 9-5-1 at home and 7-10-1 on the road.

☞ Twins have won eight of their last 11 series overall, dating back to June 12-14 vs. St. Louis.
☞ Twins are seeking their fourth-straight series win at home, since that aforementioned series.
☞ Twins last series win against the A's was June 2-5, 2025, winning two of three at Sacramento...their last at Target Field was June 13-16, 2024, sweeping in four.

LEFT TURNS: Minnesota is facing a left-handed starter for the 34th time...they have gone 14-19 against lefty starters this season...their last game vs. a left-handed starter (excluding Openers) was Friday night, a 2-0 loss to the Athletics and Jacob Lopez.

☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .298 (17-for-57) with a .920 OPS vs. lefties this season.
☞ Since June 9, Josh Bell is hitting .302 (13-for-43) with an .836 OPS vs. lefties.
☞ Since April 7, Byron Buxton is hitting .304 (24-for-79) with an .867 OPS vs. lefties.

YOU DON'T KNOW JAX: Over his last 12 games, Alex Jackson is hitting .423 (11-for-26) with three doubles, one home run, four RBI, six runs scored, one walk and just five strikeouts...in that same span, he has posted a .464 on-base percentage, a .654 slugging percentage and a 1.118 OPS.

☞ Additionally, he has hit safely in five of his last six starts, recording multiple hits in three of those.
☞ Today will mark his first career professional game at first base at the major league or minor league level.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: Twins have named High-A Cedar Rapids catcher Eduardo Tait and Double-A Wichita right-handed pitcher Cory Lewis as their minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

☞ Tait, 19, played in six games for the Kernels, hitting three home runs with six RBI, a .600 slugging percentage and an .850 OPS...the Panama native was acquired from Philadelphia along with Mick Abel at last year's trade deadline, in exchange for Jhoan Duran.
☞ Lewis, 25, pitched in two games (1 start) for the Wind Surge, pitching 8.0 shutout innings, with six hits allowed, one walk and 10 strikeouts...the Fountain Valley, California native was selected by the Twins in the ninth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of the University of California, Santa Barbara.
