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THE TWINS: Began their six-game, seven-day homestand with a 2-1 series win against the Athletics over the weekend, taking games two and three...tonight, they will continue the homestand with the first of three against the Royals through Thursday afternoon.
⌘ A win tonight and the Twins will get back to .500 for the first time since beginning post-All-Star break with a win over Chicago-NL on July 17, which put them at 49-49...with a series win over the Royals, they will be over .500 for the first time since late night of April 21 at New York-NL, when they beat the Mets and improved to 12-11.

A+ SERIES WIN: The Twins beat the Athletics on Sunday afternoon by a score of 11-8, scoring six runs in the first two innings...Minnesota won their ninth series in their last 12 chances...Connor Prielipp (3-5) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on two hits in 5.2 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts...the offense recorded 13 hits and struck out just six times...Ryan Jeffers, Ryan Kreidler and Kody Clemens each had three hits apiece as Jeffers drove in three runs...Kreidler set a single-game career-high with seven total bases, hitting two doubles and a triple.

MISTER ANDERSON, SURPRISED TO SEE ME?: The Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Cole Sands on the 15-day Injured List with a right elbow strain...Sands has gone 1-1, 8.25 ERA (12.0 IP, 11 ER), five walks and 11 strikeouts in 13 games for the Twins this season.
⌘ To replace Sands on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Jack Anderson from Triple-A St. Paul...Anderson has appeared in three games for Minnesota this season, pitching 3.1 scoreless innings with one save, one hit allowed, one walk and four strikeouts.

ROYAL AFFAIR: The Twins and Royals are playing each other today for the eighth of 13 games in 2026...Twins have gone 2-5 vs. KC this season, 1-2 at Kauffman (March 30-April 2) and 1-3 at Target Field (June 4-7).

⌘ Since the start of 2023, the Twins have gone 16-8 at home vs. the Royals, compared to 8-14 at Kauffman Stadium.

⌘ Josh Bell is hitting .308 (33-for-107) with seven doubles, eight home runs, 26 RBI and a .987 OPS in 30 career games vs. Kansas City...three of his 13 home runs this season have been against the Royals (April 1 off Falter, April 2 off Cruz and June 7 off Way).

⌘ In five games against the Royals this season, Kody Clemens is hitting .474 (9-for-19) with two doubles, three home runs, three RBI and a 1.553 OPS...he has 14 career hits against the Royals, seven of which are home runs.

⌘ Clemens has three career homers against Seth Lugo, tied for the most home runs Lugo has allowed to a single opponent in his career (also, Nolan Arenado and Junior Caminero).

KODE RED HOT: Kody Clemens has 18 home runs, one shy of his single-season career high of 19, set last year...he has also set single-season career-highs in runs (49), hits (82), triples (5) and stolen bases (7).

⌘ Since June 1, he's homered 12 times, fourth-most in the AL, trailing Junior Caminero (16), Yordan Alvarez (14) and Ben Rice (14).

⌘ Among AL players with at least 350 plate appearances this season, he ranks ninth in slugging percentage (.488).

E-LUKE-TRIFYING: In 18 games this month, Luke Keaschall is hitting .327 (17-for-52) with a .946 OPS...below is his June and July comparisons:

RYAN KING: Ryan Jeffers has reached base safely in a career-high 18-straight games...over those 18 games, he is hitting .308 (20-for-65) with six doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI, 10 walks, a .400 on-base percentage, a .631 slugging percentage and a 1.031 OPS.

⌘ 18-straight games reaching base is tied for the longest streak for a Twin this season with Trevor Larnach (4/9-5/5)...longest on-base streak for a Twin since Brooks Lee's 19-gamer from May 28-June 20, 2025.

'NACH ON WOOD: Over his last 29 games, since June 14, Trevor Larnach is hitting .369 (38-for-103) with nine doubles, five home runs, 21 RBI, a .420 on-base percentage, a .602 slugging percentage and a 1.022 OPS.

⌘ Larnach is hitting .293 (81-for-276) on the season, sixth-highest average in the AL among players with at least 315 plate appearances...he trails Yordan Alvarez (.323), Yandy Diaz (.303), Ernie Clement (.296), Chandler Simpson (.296) and Josh Jung (.294).

REST IN PEACE, LEGEND: Former University of Minnesota baseball coach John Anderson passed away on Sunday...Anderson was involved with University of Minnesota baseball for 45 years, first as a player from 1974-75, then as a student coach, a graduate assistant, an assistant coach and, since 1981, as the Golden Gophers head coach...building upon the foundation of his mentor, the iconic Dick Siebert, and with a philosophy to prepare his players "for the next 50 years of their lives," Anderson made an indelible impact upon the University and the sport...an eight-time Big Ten Coach of the Year and the winningest coach in school history with a record of 1,317-887-3 (.598), Anderson guided the Gophers to winning seasons in 36 of his 38 years at the helm, along with 24 finishes of second or better in the conference (including 11 regular season Big Ten titles), 20 tournament championship games (a conference-best 10 Big Ten tournament titles) and 19 NCAA postseason appearances...he has also mentored 328 Academic All-Big Ten selections, while coaching at least 20 future major leaguers (including former Twins All-Star closer Glen Perkins and Royals TV play-by-play man Ryan Lefebvre)...Anderson has been inducted into four different organizations' halls of fame: the American Baseball Coaches Association (2008), the University of Minnesota "M" Club (2002), the Minnesota High School Baseball Coaches Association (2013) and Hibbing Community College.

⌘ The Twins honored Anderson with the Herb Carneal Lifetime Achievement Award in 2019.
