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THE TWINS: Have gone 2-1 through three games on their six-game, seven-day roadtrip, winning the bookend games to earn a 2-1 series victory in Houston this week...tonight, Minnesota will continue the roadtrip with the first of three against the Yankees in the Bronx through the weekend. **☞** Twins are 7-3 this season following an off-day...their seven wins are March 28 at Baltimore, April 21 at New York-NL, May 5 at Washington, May 12 vs. Miami, May 22 at Boston, June 18 at Texas and June 28 vs. Colorado. **☞** Twins have won three of their last four, four of their last six and 10 of their last 16.

TAJ IS LIKE; HALF MAN, HALF AMAZING: The Twins beat the Astros on Wednesday night at Daikin Park by a score of 8-3, winning their fifth series in their last six chances...Taj Bradley (7-3) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with three walks and a career-high-tying 11 strikeouts (21 batters faced)...the offense recorded eight hits and walked six times...Trevor Larnach had three hits...Kody Clemens (14), Josh Bell (11) and Luke Keaschall (3) each homered. **☞** Bradley recorded 10-consecutive outs via strikeout from the end of the first inning to the end of the fourth inning, setting a Twins record (*Elias Sports Bureau*).

NEW YORK GROOVE: The Twins and Yankees are playing for the first of six games in 2026...Twins will host New York for three games from September 14-16. **☞** Twins went 2-4 against the Yankees last season, going 1-2 at Yankee Stadium from August 11-13 and 1-2 at Target Field from September 15-17. **☞** Trevor Larnach has hit safely in five-straight vs. the Yankees, hitting .313 (5-for-16) with two doubles, two home runs, three walks, a .400 on-base percentage, an .813 slugging percentage and a 1.213 OPS in that span. **☞** Brooks Lee is hitting .400 (6-for-15) with one double, one home run and a 1.067 OPS in four career games vs. the Yankees — all coming last season. **☞** Lifetime against Gerrit Cole: Buxton is 2-for-7 with two home runs and four RBI...Larnach is 2-for-7 with one home run and one walk.

HOTELS AND HANDSHAKES: Since the start of their last roadtrip that began on June 15, the Twins have gone 7-2 in nine road games...they went 3-0 at Texas (June 15-18), 2-1 at Arizona (June 19-21) and 2-1 in Houston (June 29-July 1). **☞** In those nine road games, they have hit .294 (97-for-330) and averaged 7.4 runs-per-game...they have outscored opponents 67-39. **☞** They have scored in the first inning in six of those nine games, totaling 16 runs in those innings...over that span of games, the 16 first-inning runs have accounted for 24% of their 67 total runs scored.

HEAT ADVISORY: Since June 1, the Twins are slugging .469, which ranks fourth best in baseball, trailing Colorado (.497), Chicago-NL (.470) and Detroit (.469). **☞** Twins have homered in all but four of their last 25 games since June 4, hitting 45 in that span...since that date, they rank second in baseball in homers, trailing the Athletics (47).

I GOT A FEVER AND THE ONLY PRESCRIPTION IS MORE JOSH BELL: Since June 1, Josh Bell is hitting .293 (29-for-99) with seven doubles, one triple, six home runs, 24 RBI, a .346 on-base percentage, a .566 slugging percentage and a .911 OPS in 28 games. **☞** He leads the club with 56 RBI for the season...24 of those RBI have come in his last 24 games...he has at least one RBI in 16 of those 24. **☞** Bell has a career-high 16-game road hitting streak (since May 28), hitting .349 (22-for-63) with a 1.055 OPS in that span...it's the longest active road streak in baseball and tied for fourth-longest in baseball this season; Paul Goldschmidt's 20-gamer is the longest...Justin Morneau holds the club record with 34-straight in 2006...Bell's is the longest by a Twin since Jorge Polanco's 20-game road hitting streak in 2019.

I AM THE ONE WHO 'NACHS: Over his last 14 games, Trevor Larnach is hitting .426 (23-for-54) with six doubles, two home runs, 12 RBI, a .456 on-base percentage, a .648 slugging percentage and a 1.104 OPS. **☞** Since the start of June, he is hitting .358 (29-for-81) with eight doubles, two home runs, 13 RBI, seven walks and a .947 OPS in 24 games...his batting average is fourth highest in baseball among players with at least 85 plate appearances since June 1.

37 CARAT MAGIC IN THE AIR: Since the start of June, Victor Caratini is hitting .338 (23-for-68) with four doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI, 10 walks, a .432 on-base percentage, a .618 slugging percentage and a 1.050 OPS...among all AL players with a minimum of 70 plate appearances in that span, he ranks second in OPS, third in on-base percentage, and seventh in slugging and average. **☞** By comparison, his slashline in March/April was .221/.312/.273 (.585 OPS) and .143/.261/.214 (.475 OPS) in May.

KREI ME A RIVER: Over his last 14 games, Ryan Kreidler is hitting .366 (15-for-41) with one double, one triple, two home runs, 12 RBI, a .409 on-base percentage, a .585 slugging percentage and a .994 OPS. **☞** Kreidler has made starts defensively at shortstop (12), centerfield (12), third base (4) and leftfield (2) this season.

CAPTAIN AMERICA: Outfielder Walker Jenkins has been named to the AL squad for the SiriusXM Futures Game, replacing teammate Kaelen Culpepper (inactive)...Jenkins is MLB.com's 14th-best prospect...the game will be played at Citizen Bank Park on Sunday, July 12.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2020, the Twins began Summer Camp at Target Field, serving as the club's "second spring training"...the Twins played 19 spring training games prior to leaving camp due to COVID-19 and flew home on March 15...the Twins held Summer Camp from July 3-21 and played Intrasquad scrimmages, with Team Polanco (white tops) vs. Team Kepler (blue tops)...they opened the 2020 regular season at Chicago-AL on July 24...in 2010, Jim Thome hit career home runs 573 and 574 at Target Field vs. Tampa Bay, both off Wade Davis...his 574th moved him past Harmon Killebrew and into sole possession of 10th on baseball's all-time home run list.
