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THE TWINS: Have gone 3-2 through five games on their six-game, seven-day homestand, winning a series 2-1 against the Athletics over the weekend, followed by a 1-1 split of the first two games against the Royals this week...today, they will complete the homestand with the three-game series finale against Kansas City...after today's game, Minnesota will travel to Seattle to begin a nine-game, 10-day roadtrip with three against the Mariners (this weekend), three at Kansas City (August 4-6) and three at Milwaukee (August 7-9).

✦ Twins have gone 11-7 in rubber games this season...they are 7-2 in their last nine rubber game chances...they won their last such instance, on Sunday vs. the Athletics.

DOBINATION: The Twins were shut out by the Royals last night at Target Field losing by a score of 4-0, suffering their fourth shutout this season...Joe Ryan (6-7) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing four runs on eight hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and four strikeouts...Kendry Rojas pitched 3.0 scoreless innings of relief with four strikeouts...the offense recorded five hits, one going for extra bases, a Ryan Kreidler double.

ROYAL FAMILY: The Twins and Royals are playing each other today for the 10th of 13 games in 2026...Twins have gone 3-6 vs. KC this season, 1-2 at Kauffman and 2-4 at Target Field...these two will meet for a final series from August 4-6, three games at Kauffman, during the middle of the next roadtrip.

✦ Since the start of 2023, the Twins have gone 17-9 at home vs. the Royals, compared to 8-14 at Kauffman Stadium.

✦ Josh Bell is hitting .307 (35-for-114) with seven doubles, eight home runs, 27 RBI and a .967 OPS in 32 career games vs. Kansas City...three of his 13 home runs this season have been against the Royals (April 1 off Falter, April 2 off Cruz and June 7 off Way).

✦ In seven games against the Royals this season, Kody Clemens is hitting .423 (11-for-26) with three doubles, three home runs, three RBI and a 1.349 OPS...he has 16 career hits against the Royals, seven of which are home runs.

TOP JEFF: Ryan Jeffers has reached base safely in a career-high 19-straight games...over those 19 games, he is hitting .309 (21-for-68) with six doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI, 11 walks, a .405 on-base percentage, a .618 slugging percentage and a 1.023 OPS.

✦ 18-straight games reaching base is the longest on-base streak for a Twin this season and is the longest on-base streak for a Twin since Brooks Lee's 19-gamer from May 28-June 20, 2025...enters today tied for the third-longest on-base streak in MLB.

✦ Jeffers has reached base safely in 11-straight home games, posting a .422 OBP in that span.

THERE'S NO KREI-ING IN BASEBALL: Ryan Kreidler has six hits in his last 14 at-bats (.429) with four doubles, one triple and three stolen bases over four games.

✦ Today marks the 11th time in the club's last 12 games in which Kreidler has started at short, and 16th in the last 21.

✦ Kreidler has set career-highs in games (64), runs (24), hits (41), doubles (8), triples (3), home runs (5), RBI (25) and walks (12).

TWINS TRY TO MEATLOAF THE ROYALS: A win today and the Twins will earn their 18th series victory of the season...they have gone 17-15-2 in series play, 10-5-1 at home and 7-10-1 on the road.

✦ Twins began the season going 8-13-1 in their first 22 series through June 11, but have gone 9-2-1 their last 12 series overall, dating back to June 12-14 vs. St. Louis.

✦ Twins are seeking their fifth-straight series win at home, which would be their longest stretch since April 14-May 11, 2025, when they won five-straight.

✦ Twins are seeking their first series win over the Royals since August 8-10, 2025 at home.

THE MISSILE: Kody Clemens has 18 home runs, one shy of his single-season career high of 19, set last year...he has also set single-season career-highs in runs (50), hits (84), triples (5) and stolen bases (7).

✦ Since June 1, he's homered 12 times, tied with Kazuma Okamoto and Spencer Torkelson for fourth-most in the AL, trailing Junior Caminero (16), Yordan Alvarez (15) and Ben Rice (14).

✦ Among AL players with at least 375 plate appearances this season, he ranks eighth in slugging percentage (.487).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2021, the Twins acquired Austin Martin and Simeon Woods Richardson via trade with the Blue Jays, in exchange for José Berrios.
