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THE TWINS: Have gone 2-2 through four games on their six-game, seven-day roadtrip, going 2-1 in Houston, followed by a loss last night at Yankee Stadium...today, Minnesota will continue the roadtrip with the second of three against the Yankees in the Bronx through tomorrow...after tomorrow afternoon's series finale, Minnesota will travel home to enjoy an off-day on Monday, then begin a six-game homestand, with three against the Guardians (Tuesday-Thursday) and three against the Angels (next weekend).

BRONX BUMMER: The Twins lost to the Yankees last night in the Bronx, by a score of 5-2...Mike Paredes was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing three runs on four hits (2 HR) in 4.0 innings pitched, with two walks and two strikeouts...Kody Funderburk pitched 2.0 hitless innings of relief, with two strikeouts...the offense recorded six hits, two apiece from Kody Clemens and Luke Keaschall...Clemens homered in the first inning, his 15th of the season.

TWINS-YANKEES: The Twins and Yankees are playing for the second of six games in 2026...Twins will host New York for three games from September 14-16.

⌘ In six games against the Yankees last season, Byron Buxton posted a .930 OPS and reached base safely in all six...he recorded three doubles, one home run and four walks, with a .545 slugging percentage.

CITY OF BUCK-ERLY LOVE: Byron Buxton is back in the lineup today after missing the last four games with right hip discomfort...he last played on June 28 vs. Colorado (at DH) and he last played in centerfield on June 27...Phase 2 voting for the All-Star Game concluded on Thursday morning and Byron Buxton was sitting in second place among AL outfielder, trailing Mike Trout...full rosters will be revealed tonight at 7:30 pm (ET) on FOX...below are Buxton's rankings among AL outfielders in a few offensive categories on the season, among qualifiers:

ADDITIONALLY...Buxton ranks third among that same group in RBI (43), trailing Bellinger (49) and Adell (45).

BEST OF: The Twins need wins today and tomorrow to win their 14th series of the season...they have gone 13-14-1 in series play, 7-5-1 at home and 6-9-0 on the road.

⌘ Twins have won five of their last six series, taking series from St. Louis (6/12-14), Texas (6/15-18), Arizona (6/19-21), Colorado (6/26-28) and Houston (6/29-7/1)...their only series loss in that span was a sweep by Los Angeles-NL (6/22-24).

⌘ Twins would be seeking their fourth-straight road series win, which would mark the first time since June 21-July 10, 2024, when they took four-straight at Oakland, at Arizona, at Seattle and at Chicago-AL.

⌘ Twins looking for their first series win over the Yankees since taking two of three at Target Field from April 24-25, 2023...their last series win at Yankee Stadium was May 30-June 1, 2014 (2 of 3) - one of just two series wins Minnesota has had in this ballpark, the other was July 12-14, 2013 (2 of 3)...they are 2-12-2 all-time in series play in this park.

FLIGHTS AND FIST BUMPS: Since the start of their last roadtrip that began on June 15, the Twins have gone 7-3 in 10 road games...they went 3-0 at Texas (June 15-18), 2-1 at Arizona (June 19-21), 2-1 in Houston (June 29-July 1) and 0-1 in New York.

⌘ In those 10 road games, they have hit .284 (103-for-363) and averaged 6.9 runs-per-game...they have outscored opponents 69-44.

⌘ They have scored in the first inning in seven of those 10 games, totaling 17 runs in those innings...over that span of games, the 17 first-inning runs have accounted for 25% of their 69 total runs scored.

THE "WE'RE FAMILIAR WITH THE CLEMENS NAME" TOUR CONTINUES: Kody Clemens hit is 15th home run of the season last night and is now four shy of his single-season career-high of 19, set last season...he is now two shy of 50 for his career.

⌘ Last night's homer broke a tie with Brooks Lee (14) for second-most homers on the team (15)...Byron Buxton is the club leader with 25.

⌘ He has homered in six of his last seven series, homering in Chicago (5/27), Pittsburgh (5/29), Detroit (6/9), Texas (6/16), Houston (7/1) and New York (last night)...his only miss was the Arizona series (6/19-21).

⌘ Since being acquired in a trade with Philadelphia in late April of 2025, Clemens has 34 home runs in 187 games (675 plate appearances)...second-most home runs on the club in that time, trailing only Buxton (54).

HE'S E-LUKE-TRIC: Over his last 15 games, Luke Keaschall is hitting .302 (13-for-43) with two doubles, one home run, 11 runs scored, eight walks, two stolen bases, a .423 on-base percentage and an .842 OPS...in that span, in road games only, he is slashing .429/.543/.607 (1.150 OPS) with 12 hits in nine games.

THE 250th: The Twins have an all-time record of 35-35 on July 4...Twins haven't lost on the Fourth of July since 2019 at Oakland...below are Fourth results over the last five seasons:
