THE TWINS: Completed their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with a record of 4-2, going 2-1 in Houston and 2-1 in the Bronx...tonight, the Twins will begin a six-game homestand, with the first of three against the Guardians through Thursday...after this series, the Twins will host the Angels for three games over the weekend, leading up to the All-Star Break.

TWINS SPOIL NEW YORK'S 250 WEEKEND: The Twins beat the Yankees on Sunday afternoon in Yankee Stadium by a score of 6-1, winning their first series in the Bronx since 2014... All-Star Joe Ryan (6-5) was the starter and winner, pitching 7.0 shutout innings, with three hits allowed, one walk and nine strikeouts...the offense recorded 12 hits, three from Brooks Lee, who doubled once, singled twice and had one RBI...Royce Lewis went 2-for-4 with a walk and two RBI...Twins went 5-for-18 with runners in scoring position, their third-most ABs with RISP this season.

WINNESOTA: Since June 14, the Twins have gone 12-7, posting a winning percentage of .632, the best in the AL since that date...below are overall MLB rankings since June 14:

OHIO PLAYERS: The Twins and Guardians are playing the fourth of 13 meetings today...these two last met for three games from May 8-10 in Cleveland as the Twins won games two and three.
⌘ This week, the Twins are seeking their first series win over the Guardians at Target Field since May 13-15, 2022, when they took two of three here.

⌘ Since the start of 2024, 18 of the 29 games between these two have been decided by two runs-or-fewer (Twins 5-13 in those)...and 13 have been decided by one run (Twins 4-9).

⌘ Austin Martin is hitting .375 (15-for-40) with three stolen bases and an .815 OPS in 14 career games against the Guardians.

⌘ Over his last four games vs. the Guards, Brooks Lee is hitting .375 (6-for-16) with one double, three RBI and a .938 OPS.

LET'S GO: The Twins have activated right-handed pitcher Woosuk Go to the 26-man roster... Go, who was acquired from the Tigers in exchange for cash considerations on Sunday, has split the 2026 season between Double-A Erie and Triple-A Toledo in the Tigers organization, combining to go 3-1, 1.96 ERA (41.1 IP, 9 ER), one home run allowed, 13 walks, 54 strikeouts, a 0.82 WHIP and a .145 (21-for-145) opponent batting average in 27 games (1 start)...since the start of June, nine of his 10 appearances for Toledo have been scoreless, posting a 1.35 ERA (13.1 IP, 2 ER) with three walks to 11 strikeouts in that span...the 27-year-old was originally signed by the Padres to a minor league deal in January of 2024 and has spent three seasons in the minor league systems of the Padres, Marlins and Tigers...prior to playing in the United States, the Ganghwa-gun, South Korea native pitched for seven seasons with the LG Twins in the KBO League from 2017-23.

⌘ To make room, the Twins optioned right-handed pitcher Cody Laweryson to Triple-A St. Paul.

⌘ Go will be the first pitcher in Twins history to wear uniform number one.

⌘ He will be the third South Korean-born player to play for Minnesota, joining ByungHo Park (2016) and Rob Refsnyder (2021).

BAD NEWS ON BUCK: The Twins announced today that they have placed outfielder Byron Buxton on the 10-day Injured List with a right hip strain (retroactive to July 6)...recently named one of the starting outfielders for the American League in the 2026 All-Star Game, Buxton has hit .271 (83-for-306) with 16 doubles, one triple, 25 home runs, 45 RBI, 57 runs scored, seven stolen bases, a .328 on-base percentage, a .575 slugging percentage and a .904 OPS.

⌘ To replace Buxton on the 26-man roster, the Twins recalled outfielder Alan Roden from Triple-A St. Paul...Roden, 26, played in 33 games for the Saints this season, hitting .272 (34-for-125) with six doubles, eight home runs, 24 RBI, 22 runs scored, 24 walks, a .397 on-base percentage, a .512 slugging percentage and a .909 OPS.

IF YOU AIN'T FIRST, YOU'RE LAST: Twins have scored 59 runs in the first inning this season, third-most in baseball, trailing Washington (69) and Houston (64).

⌘ Since June 15, they have scored in the first inning in 12 of 18 games (8-4 record in those 12), totaling 24 runs in those innings...over that span of games, the 24 first-inning runs have accounted for 22% of their 110 total runs scored.

⌘ 59 runs in the first are their third-most in any inning...they have scored 67 in the fourth inning and 65 in the fifth inning.

LEFT TURNS: Minnesota is facing a left-handed starter for the 28th time...they have gone 12-15 against lefty starters this season...their last game and win vs. a lefty was on Sunday at New York-AL, a 6-1 victory over Ryan Weathers.

⌘ Since April 7, Byron Buxton is hitting .319 (23-for-72) with a .542 slugging percentage and a .913 OPS vs. lefties.

I GOT A FEVER AND THE ONLY PRESCRIPTION IS MORE JOSH BELL: Since June 1, Josh Bell is hitting .297 (33-for-111) with eight doubles, one triple, eight home runs, 28 RBI, a .355 on-base percentage, a .604 slugging percentage and a .959 OPS in 31 games.

⌘ He is tied for third in the AL in RBI (60)...28 of those RBI have come in his last 27 games...he has at least one RBI in 18 of those 27.

WHEN LIFE GIVES YOU CLEMENS: Kody Clemens has 16 home runs, three shy of his single-season career-high of 19, set last season...he has homered in five of his last nine games...he is one homer away from 50 for his career.

⌘ Since June 1, he has homered 10 times, tied with Nick Kurtz for second-most in the AL since that date, trailing Junior Caminero (13).

⌘ He has homered in six of his last seven series, homering in Chicago (5/27), Pittsburgh (5/29), Detroit (6/9), Texas (6/16), Houston (7/1) and New York (7/3 & 7/4)...his only miss was the Arizona series (6/19-21).

⌘ Clemens ranks 14th in the AL in at-bats-per-home run (17.38).

MONTHLY WINNERS: Triple-A St. Paul outfielder Matt Wallner was named International League Player of the Month and Low-A Fort Myers catcher Ryan Sprock was named Florida State League Player of the Month.

⌘ Wallner slashed .315/.390/.730 (1.120 OPS) with four doubles, 11 home runs and 28 RBI in 22 games for the Saints...he led the International League in home runs, RBI and total bases (65).

⌘ Sprock slashed .400/.535/.600 in 21 games for the Mighty Mussels, leading the league in average (.400), hits (30), on-base percentage (.535) and OPS (1.135), while ranking fifth in RBI (18).

RIP, DARRELL JACKSON: Former Twins pitcher Darrell Jackson passed away on Sunday at the age of 70...he pitched in parts of five seasons for Minnesota, from 1978-82, appearing in 102 games (60 starts).
