THE TWINS: After completing their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with a record of 4-2 (2-1 in Houston and 2-1 in the Bronx), the Twins began their six-game homestand with consecutive victories over the Guardians the last two nights...today, they will play the three-game series finale against the Guardians...starting tomorrow night, the Twins will host the Angels for three games over the weekend, leading up to the All-Star Break.
⌘ Twins have won four-straight, five of their last six and seven of their last nine.
⌘ A win today would put the Twins back at .500 for the first time since they were 12-12 through their game on April 22 at New York-NL.

IT'S AL OVER!: The Twins beat the Guardians last night at Target Field by a score of 6-5 in walk-off fashion...Connor Prielipp was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and six strikeouts...all three of Prielipp's runs allowed came on back-to-back home runs from Bryan Rocchio (2-run) and Rhys Hoskins (solo)...the offense recorded 11 hits and were led by Kody Clemens, who went 3-for-4 with a double, a walk and one RBI...Alan Roden made his 2026 debut and went 2-for-5 with two RBI, including his first career walk-off hit in the big leagues...marked the second walk-off victory for the Twins this season (June 26 vs. Colorado - Royce Lewis single).

SERIES-LY? THAT'S GREAT: Twins have won seven of their last eight series, taking series from St. Louis (6/12-14), Texas (6/15-18), Arizona (6/19-21), Colorado (6/26-28), Houston (6/29-7/1), New York-AL (7/3-5) and Cleveland (this series)...their only series loss in that span was a sweep by Los Angeles-NL (6/22-24).
⌘ Last night marked Minnesota's fourth-straight series win, their longest since winning five-straight from May 2-18, 2025, which was part of their 13-game winning streak.
⌘ Marked the Twins' first time winning consecutive series' over Cleveland since August/September of 2021.
⌘ Twins' first series win over the Guardians at Target Field since May 13-15, 2022, when they took two of three here.

WINNESOTA: Since June 14, the Twins have gone 14-7, posting a winning percentage of .667, the best in the AL since that date...below are overall MLB rankings since June 14:

ROSTER MOVES: The Twins have returned right-handed pitcher Bailey Ober from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 15-day Injured List...Ober, who was placed on the IL on May 31 with right elbow inflammation, made two starts on rehab assignment for High-A Cedar Rapids (June 28) and Triple-A St. Paul (July 4), combining to allow seven runs on 13 hits in 8.1 innings pitched, with no walks and six strikeouts...Ober will take the 26-man roster spot vacated by right-handed pitcher Marco Raya, who was placed on the 15-day Injured List yesterday with right shoulder impingement.
⌘ Twins have also placed left-handed pitcher Connor Prielipp on the 15-day Injured List with a left middle finger blister.
⌘ To replace Prielipp on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled left-handed pitcher Kendry Rojas from St. Paul...Rojas, 23, will be making his third stint with the Twins this season and has gone 1-0, 1.65 ERA (16.1 IP, 3 ER), 13 walks, 18 strikeouts and a .214 opponent batting average in six games (2 starts) for Minnesota...he recently appeared in two games (1 start) for the Saints, going 1-0, 3.18 ERA (5.2 IP, 2 ER), one walk and six strikeouts from June 28-July 3.

ON GUARD: The Twins and Guardians are playing the sixth of 13 meetings today...Twins are 4-1 vs. the Guards this season, going 2-1 at Cleveland from May 8-10 and 2-0 in this series...these two will meet next for four games at Progressive Field from July 20-23, the back end of the first roadtrip coming out of the break.
⌘ Four-straight wins over Cleveland is Minnesota's longest since August 18-September 8, 2021 (also 4)...Twins seeking five-straight wins over the Guardians for the first time since June 1-16, 2018 (also 5).
⌘ Since the start of 2024, 20 of the 31 games between these two have been decided by two runs-or-fewer (Twins 7-13 in those)...and 14 have been decided by one run (Twins 5-9).
⌘ Twins offense has recorded 49 hits over five games vs. the Guards this season, averaging 9.8 hits-per-game and posting a batting average of .268...last time they hit over .270 against Guardians pitching over the course of a season was in 2012 (.276).

TAKE 'EM ALL: Twins are seeking their fourth sweep of the season today...their other three were a four-game sweep of the Tigers at Target Field from April 6-9, a three-game sweep of the Red Sox at Fenway Park from May 22-24 and a three-game sweep of the Rangers at Globe Life Field from June 15-18...they recorded four sweeps in 2025 — all in three games.
⌘ Last Twins sweep of the Guardians came in three games from September 11-13, 2020 at Target Field.
⌘ Twins have entered a finale with a chance to sweep six times this season, going 3-3...their three misses were April 15 vs. Boston at Target Field, June 3 vs. Chicago-AL at Target Field and July 1 at Houston.

HEY JOHN SCHNEIDER...(COUGH, COUGH) LOOK OVER HERE!: Kody Clemens has 16 home runs, three shy of his single-season career-high of 19, set last season...he has homered in five of his last 11 games...he is one homer away from 50 for his career.
⌘ Since June 1, he has homered 10 times, tied with Nick Kurtz for second-most in the AL since that date, trailing Junior Caminero (13).
⌘ He has homered in six of his last eight series, homering in Chicago (5/27), Pittsburgh (5/29), Detroit (6/9), Texas (6/16), Houston (7/1) and New York (7/3 & 7/4)...his only two misses were the Arizona series (6/19-21) and Los Angeles-NL series (6/22-24).
⌘ Among AL players with at least 300 plate appearances, he ranks seventh in slugging percentage (.507)...also has an .823 OPS, making him one of 20 AL players with an OPS of over .800.
⌘ Kody is tied for 16th in all of baseball (min. 1,000 pitches) in average exit velocity (92.9 mph)...first on the Twins.
⌘ Kody's current career-best six-game RBI streak is the longest active run in MLB.

SUMMER MOUNDNESS: Over their last 19 games, since June 16, Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 7-6, 3.12 ERA (104.0 IP, 36 ER) with 35 walks, 112 strikeouts and eight quality starts...since that date, they rank fifth in the AL in ERA...they have not allowed more than four runs in any of those starts and have allowed two runs-or-fewer in 12 of those.

PHONE, WALLET, KEAS: Luke Keaschall enters tonight with a six-game hitting streak...his season-long is seven (May 22-31) and his career-high is 11 (April 18-August 10, 2025)...over his last 19 games, Keaschall is hitting .321 (18-for-56) with three doubles, two home runs, 15 runs scored, 10 walks, two stolen bases, a .443 on-base percentage and a .925 OPS.

JUST SO FRESH, SO C-LEE-N: Brooks Lee is hitting .318 (21-for-66) with three doubles, one triple, two home runs, eight RBI, 11 runs scored, five walks, a .366 on-base percentage and an .851 OPS in his last 16 games.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2002 at Miller Park in Milwaukee, Torii Hunter (starting centerfielder), Eddie Guardado and A.J. Pierzynski represented the Twins in the All-Star Game...Pierzynski went 0-for-3, Guardado struck out both batters he faced, and Hunter went 0-for-2, but robbed a home run from Barry Bonds in the bottom of the first inning.
