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THE TWINS: Began their nine-game, 10-day homestand with a split of their first two games against the Orioles...this afternoon, the Twins will play the three-game series finale against Baltimore...tomorrow morning, the Twins will travel to Dyersville, Iowa to play the Phillies at the Field of Dreams on Thursday night...they will enjoy an off-day on Friday, then complete the series with Philadelphia at Target Field on Saturday and Sunday...they will finish the homestand next week with three against the Braves, from Monday-Wednesday.

☞ Twins have gone 12-9 in rubber games this season...they are 8-4 in their last 12 rubber game chances...they lost their last rubber match on Sunday at Milwaukee...their last rubber game win was on July 30 vs. Kansas City.

☞ Twins have allowed first inning runs in eight of their last 11 games.

TWINS CREATE TRAFFIC, BUT CAN'T CLEAR 'EM UP: The Twins lost to the Orioles last night at Target Field by a score of 5-2...Bailey Ober (7-4) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing five runs on eight hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and four strikeouts...all five of his runs allowed came on three home runs...the offense recorded seven hits, two apiece from Royce Lewis and Brooks Lee...Luke Keaschall reached base four times, going 1-for-1 with two walks and a hit-by-pitch...Twins also went 1-for-11 with runners in scoring position and left 10 men on base.

IT WAS BUILT, AND WE'RE ON THE WAY - OR WHATEVER THE MOVIE LINE IS....: Tomorrow night, the Twins will host the Phillies in Dyersville, Iowa for the third MLB at Field of Dreams Game - on Netflix...Triple-A St. Paul played their top Tuesday night against the Iowa Cubs as the Saints lost by a score of 6-3...Minnesota's No. 17 prospect, Ben Ross, homered into the cornfields in the first inning...below are the previous MLB results of the games played at that location:

ALSO...it will mark Minnesota's first neutral site home game since hosting Cleveland at Hiram Bithorn Stadium in San Juan, Puerto Rico in April of 2018 (teams split 1-1).

ORANGE IS THE NEW BLACK: The Twins and Orioles are playing each other today for the sixth and final time in 2026.

☞ These two will play six times in 2027...the Os will host the Twins for three games from August 23-25 and the Twins will host the Os for three games from September 3-5.

☞ Twins are 8-3 vs. Baltimore in their last 11 (since the start of 2025) after going 0-10 head-to-head prior to this stretch (from July 2, 2023-September 29, 2024).

☞ Josh Bell is hitting .327 (32-for-98) with eight home runs, 21 RBI, a .612 slugging percentage and a .988 OPS in 27 career games vs. the Orioles...he has hit safely in 14 of his last 18 vs. the Os...he has homered in six of his last 14 vs. the Os.

☞ Victor Caratini is hitting .318 (14-for-44) with six walks, eight RBI, a .407 on-base percentage and an .816 OPS in 16 career games vs. Baltimore.

☞ In five games against Baltimore this season, Royce Lewis is hitting .353 (6-for-17) with two home runs, four RBI and two walks.

☞ Among all MLB players with a minimum of 100 plate appearance since July 1, he ranks third in on-base percentage, ninth in OPS and 10th in batting average.

SERIES BUSINESS: Twins are seeking their 19th series victory of the season today...they have gone 18-18-2 in series play, 11-5-1 at home and 7-13-1 on the road.

☞ Twins began the season going 8-13-1 in their first 22 series through June 11, but have gone 10-5-1 in their last 16 series overall, dating back to June 12-14 vs. St. Louis.

☞ Twins are seeking their sixth-straight series win at home, which would be their longest stretch since winning nine-straight here in 2020.

☞ Twins last series win over the Orioles was a three-game sweep in Baltimore from May 14-15, 2025.

'PENSI PLAN: Over their last 18 games, the Twins bullpen has posted a 3.15 ERA (60.0 IP, 21 ER) with 33 walks, 66 strikeouts (9.9 K/9.0 IP) and a .238 opponent batting average.

☞ Since the trade deadline on August 3, Twins relievers have struck out 31 of 109 batters faced (28.4%) in 25.0 innings pitched.

LEWIS UNLOCKED: In 10 games this month, Royce Lewis is hitting .415 (17-for-41) with four doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, a .659 slugging percentage and a 1.100 OPS.

☞ Lewis' OPS by month: March/April - .666 // May - .318 // June - .841 // July - .722 // August - 1.100

☞ Among all AL players with a minimum of 40 plate appearances this month, Lewis ranks fourth in batting average (.415), and fourth in OPS (1.100) and slugging percentage (.629).

☞ Royce has now reached base safely in 21 of his last 22 games, since July 19.

☞ Royce Lewis has hit safely in seven-straight home games...he has reached safely via hit or walk in 15-straight games overall.

BE-LEE-VE IT!: Brooks Lee has recorded two hits in each of his last three games, matching a career-long (previously June 27-29)...in those three games, he has two doubles, one home run, two RBI and one walk.

☞ This season, he has already set single-season career-highs in runs (52), doubles (19), triples (3), home runs (17), walks (33) and stolen bases (7)...he needs 11 more hits (104) to match his career-high (115 in 2025) and two RBI (62) to match career-high (64 in 2025).

YO-GO: Since being acquired in a trade with Tampa Bay (for cash considerations), Yoendrys Gómez has appeared in 40 games for the Twins, going 2-2, 1.80 ERA (35.0 IP, 7 ER) with a .189 opponent batting average and is 15-for-15 in save opportunities...since the start of May, he is one of just two relievers in baseball with a 100% save percentage (minimum of 10 saves) and an ERA under 2.00, the other being Josh Hader (16-for-16, 1.00 ERA).

⚔ Zebby Matthews is slated to make his 16th start of the season, 41st start of his career and second career start against the Orioles this afternoon.

⚔ In his most recent start on August 7 at Milwaukee, Zebby earned his fifth win of the season, allowing six runs (three earned) on seven hits (1 HR), with two walks and four strikeouts in 5.0 innings pitched of the Twins 8-6 win at American Family Field.

⚔ In his only career start against the Orioles on September 28, 2024 at Target Field, Matthews took the loss, allowing six runs on seven hits (2 HR), with three walks and five strikeouts in 3.0 innings pitched of the Twins 9-2 loss.

LAST TIME OUT: Zebby made his 15th start of the season on August 7 at Milwaukee opposite left-hander Shane Drohan...earned the win, pitching 5.0 innings and allowing six runs (three earned) on seven hits – including a solo home run in the first inning off the bat of Jackson Chourio – with two walks and four strikeouts in the Twins 8-6 series-opening victory...allowed three unearned runs in the second inning via Royce Lewis' fielding error with two outs; following the error Christian Yelich, Luis Lara and David Hamilton all scored.

⚔ The win was Zebby's first since June 29 at Houston, a span of five starts (winless in July).

⚔ Walked two Brewers hitters, and has now walked two-or-more hitters in each of his last six starts dating back to June 29, marking the longest streak of his career.

⚔ **COMMAND SWITCH:** Zebby has walked 16 batters in his last six starts (29.2 IP) dating back to July 4, after walking 12 batters in May and June combined (56.1 IP).

TWO STARTS AGO: Zebby made his 14th start of the season on July 31 at Seattle opposite right-hander Bryce Miller...did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on four hits – including a Cole Young solo home run in the second inning – with two walks and a career-high 10 strikeouts...allowed two runs on two hits, with two walks in the first inning before settling down and striking out seven, while walking none and allowing only two hits (1 HR) over his last 4.0 innings of work.

⚔ Struck out multiple Mariners hitters in three of his five innings, including recording all three of his outs via the strikeout in the first and fifth innings.

⚔ Surpassed his previous career high of nine strikeouts, done twice (May 24, 2025 vs. Kansas City and August 11, 2025 at New York-AAL).

⚔ Became the fifth Twin this season to record double-digit strikeouts, joining Taj Bradley (4x), Mick Abel (1x), Bailey Ober (1x) and Connor Prielipp (1x)...first time since 2021 that the Twins have had five different pitchers record 10-or-more strikeouts in a game in a single season.

FOLLOW THE LONG BALL: Zebby has allowed a home run in 11 of his 15 starts thus far this season...below is a breakdown of Zebby's stats this year in games he gives up one-or-more homers compared to when he does not allow a homer:

NUMBERS VS. BALTIMORE: Zebby has made one career start against the Orioles on September 28, 2024 at Target Field; took the loss, allowing six runs on seven hits (2 HR), with three walks and five strikeouts in 3.0 innings pitched of the Twins 9-2 loss.

⚔ That loss to the O's was the ninth loss in a row for Minnesota in a span in which the Orioles won 10 consecutive games against the Twins from July 2, 2023-September 29, 2024.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In 18 career home starts, Matthews is 5-8 with a 5.32 ERA (89.2 IP, 53 ER), 26 walks, 85 strikeouts, a .292 BAA (104-for-356) and a 1.45 WHIP; in comparison in 22 career starts on the road is 6-10 with a 5.88 ERA (113.1 IP, 74 ER), 37 walks, 119 strikeouts, a .278 (128-for-461) BAA and a 1.46 WHIP.

⚔ In six starts at Target Field this season, Matthews is 2-4 with a 2.84 ERA (38.0 IP, 12 ER), 12 walks, 22 strikeouts, a .237 (32-for-135) BAA and a 1.16 WHIP; in comparison is 3-4 with a 7.13 ERA (48.0 IP, 38 ER), 16 walks, 51 strikeouts, a .282 (55-for-195) BAA and a 1.48 WHIP in eight starts on the road.

⚔ Matthews' 2.84 ERA at home ranks first among Twins pitchers (min. 20 IP at home)...also ranks tied for eighth in the American League (min. 38 IP).

WAKE UP: Matthews has struggled in day games this season, going 1-4 with an 8.42 ERA (31.0 IP, 29 ER), 12 walks, 31 strikeouts, a .283 (36-for-127) BAA and a 1.55 WHIP in six starts during the day...in comparison is 4-4 with a 3.44 ERA (55.0 IP, 21 ER), 16 walks, 42 strikeouts, a .251 (51-for-203) BAA and a 1.22 WHIP in nine starts at night this season.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through 15 starts this season, lefties are slashing .285/.355/.480 (51-for-179) with 11 doubles, eight home runs, 19 walks and 44 strikeouts, while righties are slashing .238/.284/.477 (36-for-151) with seven doubles, nine home runs, nine walks and 29 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Zebby has used a six-pitch mix in his 15 starts with the Twins this season...here are some of his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant.

⚔ Zebby has a .143 (5-for-35) BAA his curveball, which is second behind Tommy Nance - .132 on the Twins (min. 25 PA)...additionally, has a breaking run value of four this season, which ranks in the 80th percentile among MLB pitchers.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP TAJ BRADLEY (2026: 9-4, 3.76 ERA // CAREER: 28-31, 4.58 ERA)

Right-hander Taj Bradley is scheduled to toe the rubber for the 24th time this season in tomorrow night's MLB at Field of Dreams game against the Philadelphia Phillies in Dyersville, Iowa...in his most recent start on August 8 at Milwaukee, did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on five hits, with two walks and seven strikeouts in 5.0 innings pitched of the Twins 4-3 loss at American Family Field; marked the fourth consecutive game that Bradley did not factor into the decision, which ties a career high (also: September 3-19, 2023)...tomorrow will mark his second career start against the Phillies; pitched 6.0 innings, allowing four runs (three earned) on six hits (2 HR), with two walks and six strikeouts in his lone start against Philadelphia on September 10, 2024 at Citizen's Bank Park with Tampa Bay; did not factor into the decision in that ballgame.
