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THE TWINS: Have gone 2-3 through five games on their nine-game, 10-day homestand, going 2-1 vs. Baltimore, followed by consecutive losses to the Phillies...today, the Twins will continue the homestand with the three-game series finale against Philadelphia...they will complete the homestand this week with three games against the Braves, from Monday-Wednesday.
⚡ Twins have gone just 13-25 against National League opponents this season...they have gone 4-8-0 in series play vs. the NL...they have now faced 12 of 15 NL teams; they will play Atlanta next week, San Diego next weekend and San Francisco (September 21-23).

NOT PHUN: The Twins lost to the Phillies last night at Target Field by a score of 9-1...Connor Prielipp (3-6) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing a career-high eight runs on eight hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with four walks...the offense recorded nine hits, went 1-for-14 with runners in scoring position, struck out 14 times and left 11 men on base... Luke Keaschall and Kaelen Culpepper each had two hits as Royce Lewis drove in the only run with a sixth-inning double.

LIBERTY, LIBERTY, LIBERTY: Twins and Phillies are facing off for the 31st, 32nd and 33rd times in their history this series...Twins are 16-16 all-time against Philadelphia, going 2-1 at Veterans Stadium (2002), 1-2 at the Metrodome (2004), 7-6 at Target Field in (2012, '13, '16, '24 & '26), 6-6 at Citizens Bank Park (2010, '19, '23 & '25) and 0-1 in Dyersville, Iowa (2026).
⚡ The next meeting between these two will be for three games at Citizens Bank Park from June 14-16, 2027.

E-LUKE-TRIC CITY: Over his last 13 games, Luke Keaschall is hitting .364 (16-for-44) with a 1.122 OPS...below are Luke Keaschall's offensive comparisons through June and since July 1:

⚡ Among all MLB players with a minimum of 100 plate appearance since July 1, he ranks fourth in on-base percentage and OPS, and ninth in batting average.

LEWIS YOURSELF IN THE MOMENT: In 13 games this month, Royce Lewis is hitting .370 (20-for-54) with seven doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI, a .611 slugging percentage and a 1.004 OPS.
⚡ Lewis' OPS by month: March/April - .666 // May - .318 // June - .841 // July - .722 // August - 1.004
⚡ Among all MLB players with a minimum of 50 plate appearances this month, Lewis ranks fourth in OPS, tied for fifth in batting average and tied for 10th in slugging percentage.

BUCK HUNTING: Byron Buxton's 25 home runs are ninth-most in the AL...his last home run was June 22 vs. Los Angeles-NL, a leadoff shot off Will Klein...his 16-game homer drought marks his longest of the season...it has been 68 plate appearances since his last homer.
⚡ This is Buck's longest homerless drought since going 26 games from July 22, 2023-April 21, 2024...longest in a *single season* since beginning the 2024 season with 20 games.
⚡ Over the last full calendar year - since August 16, 2025 - he has 36 home runs in 120 games.
⚡ Over his last 162 games, he has hit 50 home runs with 91 RBI in 705 plate appearances.

THE LAST DANCE: Minnesota is looking to avoid being swept today for the fifth time in 2026, the others being April 17-19 vs. Cincinnati in three games at Target Field, April 24-26 in three games at Tampa Bay, May 29-31 at Pittsburgh in three games and June 22-24 vs. Los Angeles-NL.
⚡ Twins are looking to avoid being swept by the Phillies for the first time with this being the 11th series between these two...they first started playing head-to-head in 2002.
⚡ Twins have entered a finale seven times this season attempting to avoid the sweep and have gone 3-4 in such instances...their three times avoiding the sweep were April 2 at Kansas City, May 17 vs. Milwaukee and August 6 at Kansas City.

HAWKINS LAB: Over its last 21 games, the Twins bullpen has posted a 3.08 ERA (73.0 IP, 25 ER) with 38 walks, 77 strikeouts (9.5 K/9.0 IP) and a .237 opponent batting average.
⚡ Since the trade deadline on August 3, Twins relievers have struck out 42 of 162 batters faced (25.9%) in 38.0 innings pitched.
⚡ Also since the deadline, their 3.08 ERA ranks third-lowest in the AL and tied for fifth-lowest in baseball.

BROOKS BASEBALL: Over his last six games, Brooks Lee has hit .360 (9-for-25) with two doubles, one home run, two RBI, one walk, a .385 on-base percentage, a .560 slugging percentage and a .945 OPS...he has multiple hits in four of those six...additionally, he has just six strikeouts in 26 plate appearances in that span.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: Twins have named Triple-A St. Paul right-handed pitcher Ryan Gallagher and Double-A Wichita righty Cory Lewis as their minor league co-Pitchers of the Week, and Low-A Fort Myers outfielder Murphy Hernandez and infielder Luis Fragoza co-Players of the Week.
⚡ Gallagher, 23, started on Wednesday at Iowa, allowing one run on three hits in 5.2 innings pitched, with one walk and seven strikeouts...the Sacramento, CA native was acquired by the Twins at the 2025 trade deadline from Chicago-NL, in exchange for Willi Castro.
⚡ Lewis, 25, made the start on Tuesday vs. Corpus Christi, pitching 4.0 innings with no walks and six strikeouts...the Fountain Valley, CA native was selected by the Twins in the ninth round of the 2022 MLB Draft.
⚡ Hernandez, 19, played in four games for the Mighty Mussels, hitting .467 (7-for-15) with one double, one home run, three RBI and two walks, including a four-stolen base game on Friday vs. Clearwater...the Yamasa, Dominican Republic native was signed by the Twins as an international free agent in January of 2024.
⚡ Fragoza, 19, played in five games for the Mighty Mussels, hitting .571 (8-for-14) with three home runs, six RBI, five walks and a 1.970 OPS, including a two-homer game on Thursday vs. Clearwater...the Valencia, Venezuela native was signed by the Twins as an international free agent in January of 2024.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1975, the Twins set a major league record with nine batters recording two-or-more hits in a 9-1, nine-inning victory over Cleveland...in 1990, Kirby Puckett started off in rightfield and moved to shortstop, third base and second base all in the second inning.
