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THE TWINS: Have gone 2-4 through six games on their nine-game, 10-day homestand, going 2-1 vs. Baltimore and 0-3 vs. Philadelphia...tonight, the Twins will continue the homestand with the first of three against the Braves through Wednesday afternoon.

SLUMP: The Twins lost to the Phillies yesterday afternoon by a score of 7-5, suffering their fifth sweep of the season...Dean Kremer was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on five hits in 5.1 innings pitched...he allowed a three-run homer to Alec Bohm in the sixth inning, exiting the game immediately after...Andrew Morris was issued the loss, allowing three runs in the top of the eighth inning...the offense recorded seven hits, two from Kody Clemens...Minnesota scored all its runs on homers, a first-inning grand slam by Brooks Lee and a third-inning solo homer from Kody Clemens.

ATLIENS: The Twins and Braves are playing each other in the regular season for the 29th, 30th and 31st times in their history this week...the Twins are 8-20 all-time against the Braves in the regular season, going 6-11 in Minnesota (4-2 at the Metrodome, 2-9 at Target Field) and 2-9 in Georgia (2-3 at Turner Field and 0-6 at Truist Park).

✎ The Twins have lost 11-straight against the Braves, dating back to August of 2019...their last win came on August 5, 2019, when Miguel Sanó hit a pinch-hit, 443-foot, two-run, walk-off home run to centerfield against Chris Martin, giving the Twins a 5-3 victory.

✎ It is tied for the longest losing streak to an NL opponent in Twins history...the other is against the Dodgers, from April 30, 2014-May 15, 2023...the club record for consecutive losses to any MLB opponent is 13 to the Rangers (1998-99) and Yankees (2002-03).

✎ In seven career games vs. the Braves, Byron Buxton is hitting .292 (7-for-24) with two doubles, one triple, one home run, three RBI and an .891 OPS.

✎ Luke Keaschall made his major league debut against the Braves last season at Truist Park and went 4-for-12 during the three-game series, with two doubles and two RBI...his first hit was a second-inning single off Bryce Elder on April 18.

✎ Four current Braves coaches were in the Twins organization: pitching coach Jeremy Hefner was with the Twins from 2017-19...third base coach Tommy Watkins was with the Twins from 1998-2025...major league coach Tony Diaz was with Minnesota from 2019-24...bullpen coach J.P. Martinez was with the Twins from 2015-20.

IL-WILD: Twins have gone just 13-26 against National League opponents this season...they have gone 4-8-0 in series play vs. the NL...they have faced 12 of 15 NL teams; they face Atlanta this week, San Diego next weekend and San Francisco (September 21-23).

MS. JACKSON: The Twins have placed outfielder Austin Martin on the 10-day Injured List with a left hamstring strain...Martin was removed from the game yesterday afternoon in the eighth inning after suffering the injury while tracking a fly ball in leftfield...the 27-year-old has played in 110 games for the Twins this season, hitting .241 (68-for-282) with 17 doubles, three home runs, 23 RBI, 41 runs scored, 43 walks, 12 stolen bases and a .352 on-base percentage.

✎ To replace Martin on the 26-man roster, the Twins have selected the contract of catcher Alex Jackson from Triple-A St. Paul...Jackson, who was recently designated for release or assignment, accepted his assignment to St. Paul and remained in Minnesota's organization.

RETURN OF THE G: Byron Buxton's 25 home runs are ninth-most in the AL...his last home run was June 22 vs. Los Angeles-NL, a leadoff shot off Will Klein...his 17-game homer drought marks his longest of the season...it has been 73 plate appearances since his last homer.

✎ This is Buck's longest homerless drought since going 26 games from July 22, 2023-April 21, 2024...longest in a *single season* since beginning the 2024 season with 20 games.

✎ Over the last full calendar year - since August 17, 2025 - he has 36 home runs in 120 games.

✎ Over his last 162 games, he has hit 50 home runs with 90 RBI in 705 plate appearances.

✎ Despite the homer drought, since April 13, he ranks sixth in the AL in homers (25).

SPOTTIEOTTIEDOPA-RISP-OUS: Twins finished the Philly series going 2-for-23 (.087) with runners in scoring position...despite the recent struggles, the Twins still rank second in baseball in batting average with RISP (chart in right margin).

SO FRESH, SO C-LEE-N: Yesterday afternoon's grand slam gave Brooks Lee 66 RBI on the season, setting a new single-season career-high, passing his 2025 total of 64...this season, he has already set single-season career-highs in runs (54), doubles (19), triples (3), home runs (18), walks (33) and stolen bases (7)...he needs seven more hits (108) to match his career-high (115 in 2025).

✎ Over his last seven games, Lee is hitting .345 (10-for-29) with two doubles, two home runs, six RBI, one walk, a .367 on-base percentage, a .621 slugging percentage and a .987 OPS...additionally, he has just five strikeouts in 30 plate appearances in that span.

SOUTHPAW PLAYALISTIC: Twins are facing a left-handed starter for the seventh time in their last 17 games...tonight marks the 41st lefty starter the Twins will be facing this season, going 18-22 in previous games...their last game vs. a lefty starter was Saturday against Philadelphia's Jesús Luzardo, a 9-1 defeat...their last win over a lefty starter was last Monday against Baltimore's Trevor Rogers, a 9-5 win.

✎ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .320 (24-for-75) with a .945 OPS vs. lefties this season...his batting average ranks sixth in the AL (min. 90 PA) and his OPS ranks eighth...since July 5, 2025, Jeffers is hitting .362 (46-for-127) with a .478 on-base percentage and a .990 OPS vs. left-handed pitching...since that date, he ranks first in baseball (min. 150 PA) in batting average and on-base percentage, and third in OPS.

✎ Since July 31, Royce Lewis is hitting .474 (9-for-19) vs. lefties, with two doubles and two home runs.

✎ Josh Bell has seven hits in his last 16 at-bats vs. left-handed pitching, including two home runs (off Shane Drohan on August 7 and off Grant Wolfgram on August 10).

✎ Luke Keaschall has eight hits in 14 at-bats (.571) off lefties this month, including two walks (.647 OBP).

THE LOVE BELOW: Low-A Fort Myers infielder Luis Fragoza has been named Florida State League Player of the Week...the 19-year-old played in five games for the Mighty Mussels, hitting .667 (8-for-12) with two doubles, three home runs, six RBI, nine runs scored, seven walks, five stolen bases and a 2.383 OPS...he is the club's 27th ranked prospect.

BIRTHDAY SHOUT: Catcher/first baseman Victor Caratini is celebrating his 33rd birthday today...has played in eight MLB games on his birthday, going 2-for-17 with two singles and one run scored.
