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THE TWINS: Have gone 4-4 through eight games on their nine-game, 10-day homestand, going 2-1 vs. Baltimore, 0-3 vs. Philadelphia and 2-0 vs. Atlanta...today, the Twins will complete the homestand with the three-game series finale against the Braves...after today's game, the Twins will travel to San Diego to spend an off-day, then begin a six-game roadtrip with three against the Padres over the weekend...after San Diego, they will fly north to play the A's in Sacramento for three games, from Monday-Wednesday.
⚡ Twins have gone 13-8 in their last 21 games at Target Field.
⚡ Twins have gone just 15-26 against National League opponents this season...they have gone 5-9-0 in series play vs. the NL...they have now faced 13 of 15 NL teams; they face San Diego next weekend and San Francisco (September 21-23).

YOU BRAVEHEART, MAN...I BRAVEHEART: The Twins beat the Braves last night at Target Field by a score of 4-1, winning their second series on this homestand...Zebby Matthews (7-8) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on five hits in 5.2 innings pitched, with one walk and four strikeouts...Matthews' only blemish was a solo home run by Drake Baldwin in the sixth inning...Kody Funderburk (0.1 IP), Andrew Morris (1.0 IP), A.J. Minter (1.0 IP) and Yoendrys Gómez (1.0 IP) combined to pitch 3.1 scoreless innings of one-hit ball...the offense recorded 10 hits and were led by Ryan Jeffers, who doubled twice and drove in two runs.

AND PARTIES DON'T STOP 'TIL 8 IN THE MORNING: The Twins and Braves are playing each other in the regular season for the 29th, 30th and 31st times in their history this week...the Twins are 10-20 all-time against the Braves in the regular season, going 8-11 in Minnesota (4-2 at the Metrodome, 4-9 at Target Field) and 2-9 in Georgia (2-3 at Turner Field and 0-6 at Truist Park).
⚡ Twins are seeking three consecutive wins over the Braves for the first time since they won three-straight from 2016-19; they swept in two games in 2016, then followed with a win to begin a series in 2019.
⚡ Luke Keaschall has hit safely in all five career games vs. the Braves, hitting .381 (8-for-21) with three doubles, two RBI, one walk, one stolen base, a .409 on-base percentage, a .524 slugging percentage and a .933 OPS.
⚡ In nine career games vs. the Braves, Baxley, GA native Byron Buxton is hitting .321 (9-for-28) with two doubles, one triple, one home run, three RBI and a .946 OPS.

IF YOU'RE NOT FIRST, YOU'RE LAST: Twins have scored 10 first-inning runs in their last three games combined...they have scored 76 runs in the first inning this season, their second-most of any inning (82 in fourth innings)...76 runs is tied with St. Louis for third-most in baseball, trailing Washington (89) and Detroit (82)...they are 37-25 when scoring first in a game.
⚡ Twins are 54-23 when scoring four-plus runs in a game.

SWEEP MUSIC: Twins are seeking their fourth sweep of the season today...their other three were a four-game sweep of the Tigers at Target Field from April 6-9, a three-game sweep of the Red Sox at Fenway Park from May 22-24 and a three-game sweep of the Rangers at Globe Life Field from June 15-18...they recorded four sweeps in 2025 — all in three games.
⚡ Twins have swept the Braves twice in their history: a two-game series at Turner Field from August 16-17, 2016 and a three-game series at the Metrodome from June 12-14, 2007.
⚡ Twins have entered a finale with a chance to sweep seven times this season, going 3-4...their four misses were April 15 vs. Boston at Target Field, June 3 vs. Chicago-AL at Target Field, July 1 at Houston and July 9 vs. Cleveland at Target Field.

KEA TO OUR HEARTS: Over his last 16 games, Luke Keaschall is hitting .357 (20-for-56) with a 1.055 OPS...since being inserted into the leadoff spot on Monday, he has gone 4-for-9...below are Keaschall's offensive comparisons through June and since July 1:

⚡ Among all MLB players with a minimum of 125 plate appearances since July 1, he ranks fourth in on-base percentage, fifth in OPS and sixth in average.

ENDLESS POSSI-BELL-ITIES: Josh Bell went 2-for-4 last night, extending his on-base streak to 21 games, tying his career-high (August 26, 2019-July 28, 2020) and extending his career-high for a *single season*...it marks the longest on-base streak for a Twin since Ryan Jeffers' 23-gamer from May 7-August 2...it's the second-longest active on-base streak in baseball, trailing Bryce Harper's current 22-game streak.
⚡ In 15 games this month, he is hitting .362 (21-for-58) with two doubles, four home runs, 13 RBI, seven walks, a .431 on-base percentage, a .603 slugging percentage and a 1.034 OPS...among all players in the AL with a minimum of 50 plate appearances, he ranks fifth in OPS and batting average, sixth in slugging percentage, and seventh in on-base percentage.

EXCELLENT 'PENMANSHIP: The Twins bullpen pitched 3.1 scoreless innings last night and have now strung together 9.1-straight scoreless innings since Sunday afternoon...over the last 24 games, the bullpen has posted a 2.98 ERA (84.2 IP, 28 ER) with 41 walks, 85 strikeouts (9.0 K/9.0 IP) and a .225 opponent batting average.
⚡ Since the August 3 trade deadline, the Twins' pen ERA of 3.08 ranks third-best in the AL and sixth-best in baseball.
⚡ Bullpen ERA by month: 5.15 in March/April // 4.40 in May // 6.94 in June // 2.86 in July // 3.08 in August

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2007, Johan Santana set a club record with 17 strikeouts against the Rangers at the Metrodome, allowing two hits (both to Sammy Sosa — one single and one double) and no walks in 8.0 innings as Joe Nathan pitched the ninth inning and the Twins beat the Rangers 1-0...Michael Cuddyer provided the game's only run with a homer.
