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THE TWINS: After completing their nine-game, 10-day homestand with a record of 5-4 (2-1 vs. Baltimore, 0-3 vs. Philadelphia and 3-0 vs. Atlanta), the Twins began their six-game roadtrip with a loss in San Diego last night...tonight, the Twins will continue the series with the second of three at Petco Park...after tomorrow afternoon's series finale, they will fly north to play the A's in Sacramento for three games, from Monday-Wednesday.

THAT ESCALATED QUICKLY: The Twins lost to the Padres last night at Petco Park by a score of 6-2...Connor Prielipp (3-7) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing six runs on eight hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and seven strikeouts...four runs came in the fifth inning as five of eight batters reached base (4 1Bs & BB)...the offense recorded just two hits and did not walk...Luke Keaschall singled and Kody Clemens tripled, driving in both runs in the fourth inning.

WHO'S YOUR PADRE: The Twins are playing the Padres for the 33rd, 34th and 35th times in their history this weekend...Minnesota is 21-12 all-time against San Diego...the Twins are 11-5 all-time in Minnesota (10-3 at Target Field, 1-2 at Metrodome) and 10-7 all-time in San Diego (8-6 at Petco Park, 2-1 at Qualcomm Stadium).
* Minnesota's .636 winning percentage vs. San Diego is their highest against any opponent.
* Twins are 18-9 against the Padres in their last 27 games, dating back to June of 2008.
* Trevor Larnach has nine hits in 19 career at-bats (.474) against the Padres, including two doubles, one walk and four RBI.
* In 43 career games vs. the Padres, Josh Bell is hitting .316 (49-for-155) with eight doubles, seven home runs, 20 RBI and an .890 OPS.

ROYCE ROLLS: In 18 games this month, Royce Lewis is hitting .324 (23-for-71) with seven doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI, a .507 slugging percentage and an .867 OPS...below are Lewis' numbers before June and after June (was optioned to Triple-A St. Paul from May 19-June 6):

BELL KEEPS RINGIN': Josh Bell was hit by a pitch last night in four plate appearances, extending his career-high on-base streak to 23 games...it marks the longest on-base streak for a Twin since Ryan Jeffers' 23-gamer from May 7-August 2...the last Twin with a streak of 24-plus was Ty France, from May 16-June 13, 2025 (24-straight)...it's the second-longest active on-base streak in baseball, trailing Bryce Harper's current 24-game streak.
* In 17 games this month, Bell is hitting .344 (22-for-64) with three doubles, four home runs, 14 RBI, eight walks, a .425 on-base percentage, a .578 slugging percentage and a 1.003 OPS...among AL players this month, he ranks fifth in OPS, tied for sixth in batting average, eighth in slugging percentage and 12th in on-base percentage.
* For the season, Bell has 77 RBI, seventh-most in the AL...he is on pace for 96 RBI, which would be the second-most of his career (116 in 2019) and most for a Twin since Jorge Polanco drove in 98 in 2021.

LOW-KEA SOLID SUMMER: Over his last 18 games, Luke Keaschall is hitting .354 (23-for-65) with a 1.003 OPS...since being inserted into the leadoff spot on August 17, he has gone 7-for-18 (.389)...below are Keaschall's offensive comparisons through June and since July 1:

'PEN IS MIGHTY: Over the last 26 games since July 23, the bullpen has posted a 3.08 ERA (90.2 IP, 31 ER) with 44 walks, 94 strikeouts (9.3 K/9.0 IP) and a .228 opponent batting average...since the August 3 trade deadline, the bullpen's 3.07 ERA ranks third-best in the AL and seventh-best in baseball...below are the month-by-month number comparisons from the bullpen:

SERIES ISSUES: Twins need wins tonight and tomorrow to earn their 21st series victory...they have gone 20-19-2 in series play, 13-7-1 at home and 7-12-1 on the road.
* Twins began the season going 8-13-1 in their first 22 series through June 11, but have gone 12-6-1 in their last 19 series overall, dating back to June 12-14 vs. St. Louis.
* Twins would be seeking their first road series win since taking two of three at Yankee Stadium, from July 3-5; they have gone 0-4-1 away from Minnesota since.
* Twins are 7-3-2 in series play all-time against the Padres...their last series win over the Padres came August 29-31, 2025, taking two of three at Target Field...their last series win at Petco Park came in a two-game sweep from May 20-21, 2014; 0-2-1 here since.

THE BUCK STARTS HERE: Byron Buxton's 25 home runs are 11th-most in the AL...his last home run was June 22 vs. Los Angeles-LA, a leadoff shot off Will Klein...his 21-game homer drought marks his longest of the season...it has been 88 plate appearances since his last homer.
* This is Buck's longest homerless drought since going 26 games from July 22, 2023-April 21, 2024...longest in a *single season* since beginning the 2019 season with 22 games.
* Over the last full calendar year - since August 22, 2025 - he has 35 home runs in 120 games.
* Over his last 162 games, he has hit 49 home runs with 88 RBI in 705 plate appearances.
* Despite the homer drought, since April 13, he ranks tied for sixth in the AL in homers (25).

WHEN LIFE GIVES YOU CLEMENS: After starting August going 5-for-43 (.116) in his first 11 games of the month, Kody Clemens has hit safely in five-straight games, going 8-for-18 (.444) with one double, one triple, one home run, seven RBI, a .778 slugging percentage and a 1.251 OPS...he needs two hits to reach the 100-hit mark for the first time in his career.
* Clemens ranks in MLB's 92nd percentile in average exit velocity (92.4%).

HBD, MOLLIE: Happy 70th birthday to National Baseball Hall of Famer, former Twins manager and former Twin Paul Molitor, who was born on this day in St. Paul in 1956.
