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THE TWINS: After completing their nine-game, 10-day homestand with a record of 5-4 (2-1 vs. Baltimore, 0-3 vs. Philadelphia and 3-0 vs. Atlanta), the Twins began their six-game roadtrip with consecutive losses in San Diego on Friday and Saturday...today, the Twins will continue the series with the three-game series finale at Petco Park...after today's game, they will fly north to play the A's in Sacramento for three games, from Monday-Wednesday.

GLASS CASE OF EMOTION: The Twins lost to the Padres last night at Petco Park by a score of 7-5, blowing a 5-1 lead...Dean Kremer was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on three hits in 5.1 innings pitched...Andrew Morris (4-5) was issued the loss, allowing four runs (3 earned) on three hits in the seventh inning...the offense recorded 10 hits and struck out just three times...Brooks Lee went 3-for-4, falling a triple short of the cycle...Lee hit his 19th home run, Luke Keaschall hit his eighth and Kaelen Culpepper hit his second.

STAY CLASSY, SAN DIEGO: The Twins are playing the Padres for the 35th time in their history today...Minnesota is 21-13 all-time against San Diego...the Twins are 11-5 all-time in Minnesota (10-3 at Target Field, 1-2 at Metrodome) and 10-8 all-time in San Diego (8-7 at Petco Park, 2-1 at Qualcomm Stadium).

✦ Twins are looking to avoid losing three-straight to San Diego for the first time in their history.
✦ Minnesota's .618 winning percentage vs. San Diego is their highest against any opponent.
✦ In seven career games against the Padres, Trevor Larnach is hitting .391 (9-for-23) with two doubles, four RBI and an .895 OPS.
✦ In 44 career games vs. the Padres, Josh Bell is hitting .308 (49-for-159) with eight doubles, seven home runs, 20 RBI and an .872 OPS.

ROYCE MAKING NOISE: In 19 games this month, Royce Lewis is hitting .307 (23-for-75) with seven doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI and an .822 OPS...below are Lewis' numbers before June and after June (was optioned to Triple-A St. Paul from May 19-June 6):

24/7: Josh Bell drew a walk in five plate appearances last night, extending his career-high on-base streak to 24 games...it marks the longest on-base streak for a Twin since Ty France's 24-gamer from May 16-June 13, 2025...the last Twin with a streak of 25-plus was Jorge Polanco with 37 from May 13-June 25, 2019...it's the second-longest active on-base streak in baseball, trailing Bryce Harper's current 25-game streak.

✦ In 18 games this month, Bell is hitting .324 (22-for-68) with three doubles, four home runs, 14 RBI, nine walks, a .410 on-base percentage, a .544 slugging percentage and a .954 OPS...among AL players this month, he ranks eighth in OPS.

✦ For the season, Bell has 77 RBI, tied for seventh-most in the AL...he is on pace for 95 RBI, which would be the second-most of his career (116 in 2019) and most for a Twin since Jorge Polanco drove in 98 in 2021.

✦ Lifetime off Walker Buehler, Bell is 5-for-11 (.455) with one double.

SHORT HAIR DON'T CARE: Over his last 19 games, Luke Keaschall is hitting .362 (25-for-69) with a 1.053 OPS...since being inserted into the leadoff spot on August 17, he has gone 9-for-22 (.409)...below are Keaschall's offensive comparisons through June and since July 1:

✦ Among all MLB players with a minimum of 150 plate appearances since July 1, he ranks third in average, fourth in on-base percentage and fifth in OPS.

BALLPLAYER: After starting August going 5-for-43 (.116) in his first 11 games of the month, Kody Clemens has hit safely in six-straight games, going 10-for-22 (.455) with one double, one triple, one home run, eight RBI, a .727 slugging percentage and a 1.206 OPS.
✦ Since June 16, Clemens has 21 RBI in 29 road games, tied for fourth-most in the AL since that date.

THE LAST DANCE: Minnesota is looking to avoid being swept today for the sixth time in 2026, the others being April 17-19 vs. Cincinnati (3 games), April 24-26 at Tampa Bay (3 games), May 29-31 at Pittsburgh (3 games), June 22-24 vs. Los Angeles-NL (3 games) and August 13-16 vs. Philadelphia (3 games).

✦ Twins have never been swept by the Padres in 12 previous series.
✦ Twins have entered a finale eight times this season attempting to avoid the sweep and have gone 3-5 in such instances...their three times avoiding the sweep were April 2 at Kansas City, May 17 vs. Milwaukee and August 6 at Kansas City.

CONTACT HIGH: Twins struck out three times last night and have struck out just 24 times in their last five games...this month, the Twins have posted a 19.8% strikeout rate, fifth-lowest in the AL and seventh-lowest in baseball.
✦ Luke Keaschall is the team-leader for the season, posting a 15.2% strikeout rate.

TWINS MILB WEEKLYS: Twins have named Triple-A St. Paul outfielder Walker Jenkins as their minor league Player of the Week...High-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher Adrian Bohorquez and Double-A Wichita right-handed pitcher Riley Quick have been named co-Pitchers of the Week.
✦ Jenkins, 21, played in six games for the Saints, hitting .364 (8-for-22) with two home runs, four RBI, six walks and a 1.136 OPS...the 2023 fifth overall pick is ranked as the 15th-best prospect in baseball, per MLB.com.

✦ Bohorquez, 21, made the start on Thursday at Beloit, allowing one run on one hit in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and seven strikeouts...the La Victoria, Venezuela native was signed by the Twins in January of 2023 and is the club's 18th-best prospect, per MLB.com.

✦ Quick, 22, made the start on Wednesday at Frisco, allowing one run on two hits in 4.1 innings pitched, with two walks and eight strikeouts...the Trussville, Alabama native was selected by the Twins 36th overall in the 2025 MLB Draft and is the seventh-best prospect in the system, per MLB.com.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2009, Michael Cuddyer hit two home runs in the same inning, becoming the first member of the Twins and the 53rd major league player to do so as the Twins defeated Kansas City, 10-3.
