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THE TWINS: Completed their six-game roadtrip with a record of 2-4, going 1-2 at Chicago-AL last weekend and 1-2 at Detroit this week...tonight, the Twins will begin their penultimate homestand of 2026, starting with the first of three against the Guardians through Sunday...after this series, the Twins will host the Yankees for three games, from Monday-Wednesday. **✦** Twins have 16 games remaining, seven road games and nine home games...this series will be the final three games against an AL Central opponent in 2026. **✦** Minnesota's remaining opponents have a combined winning percentage of .469, the sixth-lowest strength of schedule in baseball.

TWINS DROP FINALE IN DETROIT: The Twins lost to the Tigers on Wednesday afternoon by a score of 7-2 at Comerica Park...Zebby Matthews (9-10) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing five runs on two hits in 2.1 innings pitched, with a season-high tying four walks and two strikeouts...the pitching staff combined to walk eight batters, two short of the club's season-high...the offense recorded five hits and put just one runner in scoring position...they scored both their runs off homers from Kody Clemens (26) and Josh Bell (19).

AUSTIN MARTIN...INTENSITY. DRIVEN: The Twins have returned outfielder Austin Martin from rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List...Martin, who was placed on the IL on August 17 with a left hamstring strain, played in two games on rehab assignment this week for Triple-A St. Paul, going 3-for-8 with one triple and three RBI...prior to landing on the IL, he played in 110 games for the Twins this season, hitting .241 (68-for-282) with 17 doubles, three home runs, 23 RBI, 41 runs scored, 43 walks, 12 stolen bases and a .352 on-base percentage. **✦** To make room for Martin on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned outfielder Gabby Gonzalez to St. Paul...Gonzalez played in six games over his recent stint with Minnesota, going 1-for-6 with one hit-by-pitch.

TWINS-GUARDIANS: The Twins and Guardians are playing the 11th of 13 meetings today...Twins are 6-4 vs. Cleveland this season, going 2-1 at home and 4-3 in Cleveland...these two last met for a four-game series at Progressive Field from July 20-23 as they split 2-2...the last time the Twins hosted the Guardians was for three games from July 7-9, winning two of three. **✦** Since the start of 2024, 21 of the 36 games between these two have been decided by two runs-or-fewer (Twins 8-13 in those)...and 14 have been decided by one run (Twins 5-9). **✦** Twins have hit six homers against Cleveland pitching this season: Buxton off Festa (5/8 at CLE), Buxton off Bibee (5/9 at CLE), Lewis off Williams (7/9 at MIN), Jeffers off Messick (7/21 at CLE), Larnach off Ceconni (7/22 at CLE) and Lee off Ceconni (7/22 at CLE). **✦** Over his last 10 games vs. the Guards, Brooks Lee is hitting .302 (13-for-43) with 10 RBI. **✦** In his last 18 games vs. Cleveland, Kody Clemens is hitting .309 (21-for-68) with seven doubles, two triples, a .471 slugging percentage and a .799 OPS. **✦** Austin Martin is hitting .327 (16-for-49) with two doubles and a .749 OPS in 20 career games against the Guardians.

FOR THE LOVE OF THE 'LAND: Twins need one win in this series to secure the season-series for the first time since going 11-8 in 2021...six wins already surpasses Minnesota's 2025 total (4-9)...below are the Twins recent season records vs. Cleveland overall (left), at home (middle) and on the road (right):

BLACK AND B-LUKE: Luke Keaschall was hit by a pitch again on Wednesday afternoon, his 21st hit-by-pitch this season, tying Willi Castro's club record set in 2024...he ranks fifth in baseball in hit-by-pitches this season...below are the all-time club leaders (since 1961):

ADDITIONALLY... Keaschall ranks fifth in baseball in HBP, trailing Iván Herrera (28), Sam Antonacci (25), Randy Arozarena (23) and Willson Contreras (22).

THE LEFTORIUM: Notable numbers vs. left-handed pitching:

✦ Since July 5, 2025, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .329 (49-for-149) with a .445 on-base percentage and a .928 OPS vs. left-handed pitching...since that date, he ranks second in all of baseball in on-base percentage (minimum 150 PA), fourth in batting average and 10th in OPS. **✦** Since July 31, Royce Lewis is hitting .333 (13-for-39) vs. lefties, with two doubles, two home runs and an .888 OPS. **✦** Since August 6, Luke Keaschall is hitting .348 (16-for-46) vs. lefties, with five doubles, a .400 on-base percentage and an .857 OPS. **✦** Kaelen Culpepper is hitting .324 (12-for-37) with an .836 OPS vs. lefties this season.

WHEN LIFE GIVES YOU CLEMENS: Over his last 22 games, Kody Clemens is hitting .308 (24-for-78) with one double, one triple, six home runs, 18 RBI, a .577 slugging percentage and a .959 OPS.

✦ Wednesday afternoon, Clemens homered for the 26th time in 2026, passing Byron Buxton for team-lead in home runs. **✦** Since June 16, Clemens has 49 RBI, tied with Pete Alonso for third-most in the AL, trailing Junior Caminero (61) and Jac Caglianone (50). **✦** Clemens leads the team in average exit velocity at 92.4 mph...among AL players (min. 2,000 pitches seen) that figure ranks fifth-best, trailing Yordan Alvarez (94.2 mph), Pete Alonso (94.2 mph), Munetaka Murakami (94.0 mph) and Junior Caminero (92.9 mph).

ANSWERING THE BELL: Josh Bell hit his 19th home run of the season on Wednesday at Detroit, giving him a team-leading 86 RBI on the season...he has 14 RBI in his last 20 games. **✦** 86 RBI rank tied for fifth-best in the AL and tied for 13th-most in baseball...the last Twin to finish the regular season in the top 10 in the AL in RBI was Eddie Rosario, completing the 2020 pandemic season tied for sixth with 42 RBI...the last in a full 162-game season was Rosario (109) and Nelson Cruz (108), finishing sixth and seventh in 2019.

✦ 86 are the fourth-most of Bell's career (116 in 2019, 90 in 2017 and 88 in 2021). **✦** Bell is on pace for 95 RBI, which would be the most for a Twin since Jorge Polanco drove in 98 in 2021.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1974, Harmon Killebrew hit his final home run as a Twin, a walk-off two-run shot in the bottom of the 10th to give the Twins a 5-3 victory over Oakland...in 1999, Eric Milton threw the fourth no-hitter in Twins history, defeating the Angels 7-0 at the Metrodome...he walked two and struck out 13 batters, the most strikeouts in a no-hitter in Twins/Senators history (passing Walter Johnson's 10 K on July 1, 1920)...in 2013, *Baseball America* named Byron Buxton its Minor League Player of the Year...in 2018, Joe Mauer hit the final home run of his career, a grand slam off Tommy Kahnle.
