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THE TWINS: After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 2-4 (1-2 at Chicago-AL and 1-2 at Detroit), the Twins began their six-game homestand with a loss to Cleveland last night...today, the Twins will play the second of three against the Guardians and complete the series tomorrow afternoon...after this series, the Twins will host the Yankees for three games, from Monday-Wednesday.
⚡ Despite last night's loss, the Twins are still 6-4 in their last 10 games at home.
⚡ Twins have 15 games remaining, seven road games and eight home games.

FRIDAY NIGHT FRIGHTS: The Twins lost to the Guardians last night at Target Field by a score of 5-2...Taj Bradley was the starter but did not factor into the decision, pitching 6.0 shutout innings, with one hit allowed, four walks and six strikeouts...his final strikeout of Jo Adell in the sixth inning was the 600th of his career and 190th of his season...the bullpen combined to allow five runs on five hits and two walks in the final 3.0 innings...the offense recorded six hits, two from Kody Clemens...Royce Lewis and Kaelen Culppepper each drove in a run.

HE'S THE EM-MAN-UEL: The Twins have recalled outfielder Emmanuel Rodriguez from Triple-A St. Paul...Rodriguez, 23, has hit .262 (45-for-172) with six doubles, one triple, 11 home runs, 33 RBI, 42 walks, seven stolen bases, 36 runs scored, a .414 on-base percentage and a .914 OPS in 49 games for the Saints this season...this includes slashing .289/.417/.511 (.928 OPS) with nine extra-base hits, 15 RBI and 18 walks in his last 23 games since August 12...the Santiago, Dominican Republic native was originally signed by the Twins in July of 2019 and is currently ranked as the No. 4 prospect in the Twins system by *Baseball America* and No. 5 by MLB.com.
⚡ To make room for Rodriguez on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned infielder Ben Ross to St. Paul.

TWINS-GUARDS: The Twins and Guardians are playing the 12th of 13 meetings today...Twins are 6-5 vs. Cleveland this season, going 2-2 at home and 4-3 in Cleveland.
⚡ Since the start of 2024, 21 of the 37 games between these two have been decided by two runs-or-fewer (Twins 8-13 in those)...and 14 have been decided by one run (Twins 5-9).
⚡ In his last 19 games vs. Cleveland, Kody Clemens is hitting .319 (23-for-72) with seven doubles, two triples, a .472 slugging percentage and an .810 OPS.
⚡ Austin Martin is hitting .320 (16-for-50) with two doubles and a .757 OPS in 21 career games against the Guardians.

FOR THE LOVE OF THE 'LAND: Twins need one win in these next two days to secure the season-series for the first time since going 11-8 in 2021...six wins already surpasses Minnesota's 2025 total (4-9)...below are the Twins recent season records vs. Cleveland overall (left), at home (middle) and on the road (right):

ICY HOT THAT MAN: Luke Keaschall ranks fifth in baseball in hit-by-pitch, trailing Iván Herrera (29), Sam Antonacci (26), Randy Arozarena (23) and Willson Contreras (22)...he has been hit by 21 pitches this season, tied with Willi Castro for the club record...below are the all-time club leaders (since 1961):

THE MISSILE: Over his last 23 games, Kody Clemens is hitting .317 (26-for-78) with one double, one triple, six home runs, 18 RBI, a .573 slugging percentage and a .960 OPS.
⚡ Clemens has 26 home runs this season, leading the team, ahead of Byron Buxton (25).
⚡ Since June 16, Clemens has 49 RBI, tied with Pete Alonso for third-most in the AL, trailing Junior Caminero (63) and Jac Caglianone (50).
⚡ Clemens leads the team in average exit velocity at 92.4 mph...among AL players (min. 2,000 pitches seen) that figure ranks fifth-best, trailing Yordan Alvarez (94.2 mph), Pete Alonso (94.0 mph), Munetaka Murakami (93.8 mph) and Junior Caminero (92.9 mph).

HOUSE KEAS: Despite going 0-for-4 last night, Luke Keaschall has recorded multiple hits in nine of his last 13 home games...over those 13, he has hit .392 (20-for-51) with six doubles, two home runs, four hit-by-pitch, three walks, a .566 OBP, a .627 slug and a 1.093 OPS.

SIRI, TELL ME ABOUT SERIES: Twins need wins today and tomorrow to earn their 22nd series victory of 2026...they have gone 21-24-2 in series play, 14-8-1 at home and 7-16-1 on the road.
⚡ Twins are 2-0-1 in series play vs. the Guardians this season...the last time the Twins won three series vs. Cleveland in one season was 2021, when they went 4-2-0.
⚡ Twins last series win at home was August 31-September 2, taking two of three vs. Detroit...this would mark home series wins in consecutive chances for the first time since July 24-30 vs. the Athletics and Royals.

⚡ On-field and/or videoboard recognitions of 21 veterans service organizations: American Heroes Outdoors, Believet Golf Tournament; Beyond the Yellow Ribbon; Blue Star Mothers of America, Inc.; Camp Bliss; Can Do Canines; Gaits of Hope; Golden Valley Fire Department; McLeod County Veteran Services; Meals on Wheels; Minnesota Assistance Council for Veterans (MACV); Outdoor Warrior Nation; ROGER UP: Soldier's 6; The American Legion; The Veterans of Foreign Wars of the U.S. (VFW); United Services Organizations (USO); Veteran Resilience Project (VRP); Wounded Warrior Project (WWP) and 23rd Veteran.
⚡ The American flag will be raised by two distinguished veterans representing the Paralyzed Veterans of America Minnesota Chapter and their advocacy for quality healthcare, civil rights and adaptive sports programming that help veterans regain independence: Corporal Todd Kemery, who served in the U.S. Marine Corps from 1978 to 1983 as a Helicopter Maintenance Specialist; and Staff Sergeant Robert York, who served in the U.S. Air Force as a Flight Surgeon Surgical Assistant from 1996-2000 and in the Air National Guard from 2000-03.
⚡ The Twins Territory flag will be raised by MDVA Commissioner Brad Lindsay, a veteran of Operation Iraqi Freedom who served 14 years with the U.S. Army and is the recipient of the Combat Action Badge, the Army Achievement Medal and two awards of the Army Commendation Medal.
⚡ A ceremonial first pitch will be thrown by retired Major General Neal Loidolt, who is retiring from his position as President and CEO of MACV after a 30-year military career that included service with the Minnesota National Guard, multiple deployments and numerous honors.
⚡ The National Anthem will be performed by Specialist Austin Kulm from the 34th Red Bull Infantry Division Band.
