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THE TWINS: After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 2-4 (1-2 at Chicago-AL and 1-2 at Detroit), the Twins began their six-game homestand with a split of the first two games against Cleveland...today, the Twins will play the three-game series finale against the Guardians...after this series, the Twins will host the Yankees for three games, from Monday-Wednesday.

✦ The Twins are 7-4 in their last 11 games at home.

✦ Twins have 14 games remaining, seven road games and seven home games.

✦ Twins are playing their 61st day game today...60 day games, entering today, are seventh-most in baseball...Minnesota is 28-32 during the day...Twins haven't work back-to-back day games since July 11-12 vs. Los Angeles-AL.

✦ Twins have gone 13-12 in rubber games this season...their last rubber game was a loss on Wednesday at Detroit and their last win was on August 12 vs. Baltimore.

DYNAMITE DEBUT: The Twins beat the Guardians yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 4-3, scoring all four runs in the third inning...Connor Prielipp (5-7) was the starter and winner, allowing three runs on five hits in 5.1 innings pitched, with no walks and one strikeout...Andrew Morris (1.0), Kody Funderburk (0.2), Jeff Hoffman (1.0) and A.J. Minter (1.0) combined to pitch 3.2 no-hit innings of relief, striking out eight of 14 batters faced...Emmanuel Rodriguez made his major league debut, going 1-for-4, hitting his first home run, a solo shot in the third inning off Franco Aleman (more below).

✦ Minter's save made him the 13th different reliever in 2026 to earn a save, extending the club record for different pitchers with saves in one season.

✦ Rodriguez gave the Twins 13 players to debut in 2026, tied with St. Louis for fourth-most in baseball, trailing Chicago-AL (15), San Francisco (15) and Toronto (14)...the club record (since 1961) is 14 in 2017 and the franchise record (since 1901) is 18 in 1939.

ONE LAST TIME FOR CLEVELAND: The Twins and Guardians are playing for the 13th and final time today...Twins are 7-5 vs. Cleveland this season, going 3-2 at home and 4-3 in Cleveland.

✦ These two will meet next from April 13-15, 2027 at Progressive Field for three games...Twins will host Cleveland for four games from June 24-27, 2027.

✦ Since the start of 2024, 22 of the 38 games between these two have been decided by two runs-or-fewer (Twins 9-13 in those)...and 15 have been decided by one run (Twins 6-9).

✦ Twins have gone 4-0 in one-run games vs. Cleveland this season...they were 2-4 last season in one-run margins, 0-5 in 2024, 2-3 in 2023 and 1-8 in 2022.

WELL, WELL, WELL, HOW THE TURNTABLES..... Yesterday's win secured the season-series over the Guards for the first time since going 11-8 in 2021...seven wins surpasses Minnesota's 2025 total (4-9)...below are the Twins recent season records vs. Cleveland overall (left), at home (middle) and on the road (right):

GOING FOR THE MEATLOAF: Twins need a win today to earn their 22nd series victory of 2026...they have gone 21-24-2 in series play, 14-8-1 at home and 7-16-1 on the road.

✦ Twins are 2-0-1 in series play vs. the Guardians this season...the last time the Twins won three series vs. Cleveland in one season was 2021, when they went 4-2-0.

✦ Twins last series win at home was August 31-September 2, taking two of three vs. Detroit...this would mark home series wins in consecutive chances for the first time since July 24-30 vs. the Athletics and Royals.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: Twins have named Double-A Wichita outfielder Graham Brown and right-handed pitcher Ty Langenberg as their minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

✦ Brown, 25, played in six games for the Wind Surge, hitting .450 (9-for-20) with two doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, three walks, a .522 on-base and a 1.372 OPS...the Rockville, Maryland native was signed by the Twins as a minor league free agent in May of 2026.

✦ Langenberg, 24, made the start on Thursday vs. Frisco, allowing one run on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and four strikeouts...the Urbandale, Iowa native was selected by the Twins in the 11th round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of the University of Iowa.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2022, rookies Joe Ryan and Jovani Moran kept the Royals hitless until one out in the ninth inning, before Moran allowed a double to Bobby Witt Jr...Ryan went 7.0 hitless innings but was removed after 106 pitches.
