THE TWINS: Have gone 1-3 through four games on their current six-game homestand, going 1-2 vs. Cleveland over the weekend, followed by a loss to New York-AL last night...tonight, the Twins will continue the homestand with the second of three vs. the Yankees...they will complete the series/homestand tomorrow afternoon then begin their final roadtrip of 2026... they will play four in Anaheim from Thursday-Sunday and three in San Francisco from next Monday-Wednesday.
☞ Twins have 12 games remaining, seven road games (LAA - 4 & SF - 3) and five home games (NYY - 2 & TEX - 3).

THINGS GO NOT SO GREAT IN THE EIGHTH: The Twins lost to the Yankees last night at Target Field by a score of 8-3...Dean Kremer was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on two hits in 5.2 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts...the bullpen allowed seven runs in the final two innings, including a six-run eighth...the offense recorded six hits, walked four times and went 1-for-9 with runners in scoring position...Josh Bell had the club's only extra-base hit, hitting his 20th homer of the season in the eighth inning...Luke Keaschall walked three times in five plate appearances.

TWINS-YANKEES: The Twins and Yankees are playing for the fifth of six games in 2026... Twins are 2-2 vs. New York in 2026, going 2-1 at Yankee Stadium from July 3-5, followed by a loss last night...Twins need two wins over these next two days to win the season series over New York for the first time since going 4-3 in 2023...prior to that, their last season-series win was 2001 (4-2).
☞ Luke Keaschall has reached base safely in seven-straight vs. the Yankees, posting a .324 on-base percentage in that span.
☞ Notables vs. Yankees pitching this season: Josh Bell is 6-for-16 (.375) with one double, three homers, five RBI and two walks...Luke Keaschall is 4-for-12 (.333) with one double, one home run and three walks...Austin Martin is 2-for-3 with one double and two walks... Royce Lewis is 4-for-13 (.308) with two doubles, two RBI and one walk.

BLACK AND B-LUKE: Luke Keaschall ranks fifth in baseball in hit-by-pitch, trailing Iván Herrera (29), Sam Antonacci (27), Randy Arozarena (23) and Willson Contreras (22)...he has been hit by 21 pitches this season, tied with Willi Castro for the club record...below are the all-time club leaders (since 1961):

ALSO...four of Keaschall's 21 HBPs have come in his last 11 games.

HOUSE KEAS: Over his last 19 home games, Luke Keaschall is hitting .368 (25-for-68) with six doubles, two home runs, six RBI, six HBP, nine walks, a .476 on-base percentage and a 1.020 OPS...since the All-Star break, Keaschall ranks third in the AL in home on-base percentage (.441), ninth in batting average (.329) and 11th in OPS (.917).

THE LEFTORIUM: Notable numbers vs. left-handed pitching:

☞ Since July 31, Royce Lewis is hitting .326 (14-for-43) vs. lefties, with three doubles, two home runs and an .876 OPS.
☞ Since August 6, Luke Keaschall is hitting .308 (16-for-52) vs. lefties, with five doubles, a .357 on-base percentage and a .761 OPS.
☞ Kaelen Culppepper is hitting .308 (12-for-39) with an .810 OPS vs. lefties this season.
☞ Austin Martin is hitting .313 (5-for-16) with three doubles, one home run, two walks and a 1.138 OPS over his last seven games vs. lefties.

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: Twins need wins tonight and tomorrow to earn their 22nd series victory of 2026...they have gone 21-25-2 in series play, 14-9-1 at home and 7-16-1 on the road.
☞ Twins last series win was August 31-September 2, taking two of three vs. Detroit.
☞ The Twins need to win each of these next two games to take two series' in one season against New York for the first time since 2001.

WHAT'S YOUR 20: Josh Bell hit his 20th home run of the season last night, his sixth season with 20-plus...he now has a team-leading 87 RBI.
☞ 87 RBI rank ninth-best in the AL...the last Twin to finish the regular season in the top 10 in the AL in RBI was Eddie Rosario, completing the 2020 pandemic season tied for sixth with 42 RBI...the last in a full 162-game season was Rosario (109) and Nelson Cruz (108), finishing sixth and seventh in 2019.
☞ 87 are the fourth-most of Bell's career (116 in 2019, 90 in 2017 and 88 in 2021).
☞ Bell is on pace to finish with 93 RBI, which would be the most for a Twin since Jorge Polanco drove in 98 in 2021.

YO-GO: Since being acquired in a trade with Tampa Bay (for cash considerations) in early May, Yoendrys Gómez has appeared in 50 games for the Twins, going 2-3, 3.02 ERA (44.2 IP, 15 ER) with a .198 opponent batting average and is 21-for-21 in save opportunities...since the start of May, he is one of just two relievers in baseball with a 100% save percentage (minimum of 15 saves) and an opponent batting average under .200, the other being Josh Hader (25-for-25, .114 BAA).
☞ No Twin has ever posted a save percentage of 100% in a single season with a minimum of 15 saves...the closest to that being LaTroy Hawkins, who went 14-for-14 in 2000...after that was Jhoan Duran, who went 8-for-8 in 2022.

ROBERTO CLEMENTE AWARD: The Twins will honor Pablo López in a special pregame ceremony tonight, recognizing him as the club's nominee for the Roberto Clemente Award presented by Capital One, baseball's most prestigious individual honor for major leaguers...this is López's third-consecutive nomination with the Twins and fourth of his nine-year career, as he was also the Miami Marlins' nominee in 2022...the Roberto Clemente Award presented by Capital One is the annual recognition of a major league player who best represents the game of baseball through extraordinary character, community involvement, philanthropy and positive contributions, both on and off the field...as part of the annual program, each MLB Club nominates one player to be considered for the league-wide Award in tribute to Clemente's achievements and character.
☞ The leaguewide winner of the Roberto Clemente Award will be honored at the 2026 World Series presented by Capital One...four past Twins nominees have been named winner of the Roberto Clemente Award: Rod Carew (1977), Dave Winfield (1994), Kirby Puckett (1996) and Nelson Cruz (2021).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2002, the Twins clinched the AL Central Division title with a 5-0 win over Cleveland at then-Jacobs Field, marking the Twins' first playoff appearance since 1991...they also won the division in the next two seasons...in 2017, the Twins celebrated Big Sexy Night as Bartolo "Big Sexy" Colón made the start...Colón allowed four runs on five hits in 6.0 innings as the Twins lost to the Blue Jays by a score of 4-3...in 2023, after hitting a grand slam off Jesse Scholtens of the White Sox, Royce Lewis became the first player with five grand slams among his first 16 career homers and the first in Twins history with four in one season.
