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**THE TWINS:** Completed their six-game homestand with a record of 2-4, going 1-2 vs. Cleveland and 1-2 vs. New York-AL...tonight, Minnesota will begin their final roadtrip of 2026 with the first of four against the Los Angeles Angels in Anaheim...after this series, they will travel to San Francisco to play the Giants for three games at Oracle Park, from Friday-Sunday.  
☞ Twins have 10 games remaining, seven road games (LAA - 4 & SF - 3) and three home games (TEX - 3).

**A FLARE FOR THE DRAMATIC:** The Twins beat the Yankees yesterday at Target Field in walk-off fashion by a score of 5-4 in 13 innings, tying the longest game by innings in Major League Baseball this season...Zebby Matthews was the starter but did not factor into the decision despite making a quality start, pitching 6.0 scoreless innings on two hits, with two walks and eight strikeouts...the offense totaled 10 hits in the contest, led by a three-hit day from Luke Keaschall, a solo home run by Ryan Kreidler and a walk-off single by Victor Caratini, his first walk-off as a Twin and the seventh of his career...marked the fifth walk-off victory for the Twins this season.

**ANTHEM OF THE ANGELS:** The Twins and Angels are playing today for the fourth of seven games in 2026...Minnesota last played the Angels for three games from July 10-12, dropping the series opener before winning games two and three at Target Field.  
☞ Minnesota has gone 14-6 in its last 20 against the Angels, dating back to May of 2023...in that span, have a run differential of +48 (125-77).  
☞ Minnesota's .733 winning percentage (11-4) vs. the Angels since the start of 2024 is their highest against any MLB opponent.  
☞ In seven career games vs. LAA, Luke Keaschall is hitting .318 (7-for-22) with one double, three RBI, two hit-by-pitch, one stolen base and a .385 on-base percentage.  
☞ Over his last 13 games vs. the Angels, Trevor Larnach is hitting .404 (19-for-47) with 11 RBI, nine walks, a .491 on-base percentage and a 1.108 OPS.

**VICTOR(Y) CARATINI:** Victor Caratini delivered his sixth career walk-off hit (seventh career walk-off plate appearance) and first as a Twin in yesterday's Twins win over the Yankees, lining a single into centerfield that scored Luke Keaschall in the 13th inning...he is hitting .286 (14-for-49) in close and late situations this season, with eight RBI, eight walks and a .400 on-base percentage.  
☞ His .400 on-base percentage in close and late situations is tied for ninth highest in the American League (min. 60 plate appearances).  
☞ Since the beginning of the 2025 season, his .291 (32-for-110) batting average in close and late situations ranks third among primary catchers (min. 120 plate appearances), behind Gabriel Moreno (.310) and Shea Langeliers (.297).

**BLACK AND B-LUKE:** Luke Keaschall ranks fifth in baseball in hit-by-pitches, trailing Iván Herrera (29), Sam Antonacci (27), Randy Arozarena (23) and Willson Contreras (23)...he has been hit by 21 pitches this season, tied with Willi Castro for the club record...below are the single-season all-time club leaders (since 1961):

**BEFORE YOU LEAVE, PHONE, WALLET, KEAS:** Over his last 50 road games, Luke Keaschall is hitting .305 (54-for-177) with nine doubles, five home runs, 13 RBI, nine HBP, 21 walks, a .406 on-base percentage and an .846 OPS...has three hits in back-to-back games for the first time in his career...his 37 multi-hit games this season lead the team, and his 59 hits since the All-Star break are eighth most in the American League.

**RING MY BELL:** Josh Bell singled and drove in a run in yesterday's victory...he now has a team-leading 88 RBI.

☞ 88 RBI are tied for seventh-most in the AL...the last Twin to finish the regular season in the top 10 in the AL in RBI was Eddie Rosario, completing the 2020 pandemic season tied for sixth with 42 RBI...the last in a full 162-game season was Rosario (109) and Nelson Cruz (108), finishing sixth and seventh in 2019.  
☞ 88 RBI are tied for third-most of Bell's career (116 in 2019, 90 in 2017 and 88 in 2021).  
☞ Bell is on pace to finish with 94 RBI, which would be the most for a Twin since Jorge Polanco drove in 98 in 2021.

**BEN THERE, HIT THAT:** Ben Ross recorded the first hit of his major league career yesterday against the Yankees, doubling off Carlos Rodón in the fifth inning...became the fifth Twin to record his first major league hit this season (Gabby Gonzalez on 5/22, Kaelen Culpepper on 8/7, Walker Jenkins on 8/28 and Emmanuel Rodriguez on 9/12) and is the third to have his first career hit go for extra bases (Culpepper and Rodriguez each homered).

**DINAMITAL!** Emmanuel Rodriguez has reached safely in all five games played this season, going 5-for-19 (.263) with one double, one triple, one home run, four RBI and an .879 OPS.  
☞ His three extra-base hits through his first five games are tied for the most in Twins history (since 1961), becoming the 12th player to do so.  
☞ He's the 24th player in Twins history to reach base safely in each of his first five career games...the Twins have had a player reach safely in their first five-or-more career games in three-straight seasons (Luke Keaschall, 11-straight in 2025; Brooks Lee, 6-straight in 2024).

**CHALLENGE ACCEPTED:** Twins enter today having used the ABS challenge system 424 times, the most in baseball (next is Chicago-AL with 407)...Twins have won 232 of those challenges, also the most in baseball, posting a 55% success rate (7-6th in AL)...they have won 87 of 173 on the hitting side and 145 of 251 on the pitching side.  
☞ Victor Caratini has challenged 119 pitches as a catcher, fifth most among catchers in baseball...he has flipped 23 pitches into strikeouts, tied for third most in baseball, behind Austin Wells and Jonah Heim (both with 24).  
☞ Caratini and Ryan Jeffers have combined for 129 successful challenges behind the plate, the most by a catching tandem in Major League Baseball.  
☞ Luke Keaschall has gained five walks from challenges, tied with JJ Bleday, Cal Raleigh and Bryan Reynolds for the most in baseball...he is also tied with Bleday for the league lead in strikeouts eliminated by challenges with eight.
