THE TWINS: After completing their six-game homestand with a record of 2-4 (1-2 vs. Cleveland and 1-2 vs. New York-AL), the Twins began their final roadtrip of the season with an extra-inning loss in Anaheim last night...tonight, Minnesota will continue with the second of four games against the Angels through Sunday...after this series they will head north to San Francisco for their final road series of the season, playing three against the Giants at Oracle Park from Monday-Wednesday.

☞ Twins have nine games remaining, six road games (LAA - 3 & SF - 3) and three home games (TEX - 3).

EXTRA INNING AFFAIRS PART II: The Twins played extra innings for the second consecutive game last night, but could not secure the victory, falling 5-4 in a 10-inning, walk-off to the Angels at Angel Stadium...the Angels scored two in the 10th via two hits and one walk, including Wade Meckler's walk-off single (off Kody Funderburk), as Yoendrys Gómez took his fourth loss of the season and second blown save...Taj Bradley was the starter but did not factor into the decision, despite making his team-leading 14th quality start of the season; fired 7.0 innings, allowing three runs on five hits, with one walk and nine strikeouts (199 on the season)...the offense was quiet early, recording only four hits through the first 7.0 innings, but came alive late with six hits and all four runs in the last three frames...Walker Jenkins led the charge with the first three-hit game of his career, including a game-tying two-run home run (2) in the ninth, while Brooks Lee added a pair of hits and two RBI (81).

I CAN SEE YOUR HALO: The Twins and Angels are playing today for the fifth of seven games in 2026...Minnesota last played the Angels for three games from July 10-12, dropping the series opener before winning games two and three at Target Field.

☞ Minnesota has gone 14-7 in its last 21 against the Angels, dating back to May of 2023...in that span, have a run differential of +47 (129-82).

☞ Minnesota's .688 winning percentage (11-5) vs. the Angels since the start of 2024 is tied for their highest against any MLB opponent (also are 11-5 against Texas).

☞ Notables vs. Angels pitching this season: Brooks Lee is 4-for-12 (.333) with two doubles, three RBI, three walks and a .938 OPS...Luke Keaschall is 4-for-13 (.308) with four singles, one RBI and one run scored...Josh Bell is 4-for-16 (.250) with a team-high three doubles.

☞ In eight career games vs. LAA, Luke Keaschall is hitting .296 (8-for-27) with one double, three RBI, two hit-by-pitches, one stolen base and a .355 on-base percentage...he has reached base safely in seven of eight career games.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins announced today that they have placed outfielder Trevor Larnach on the 10-day Injured List (retroactive to September 15) with a left wrist sprain...Larnach, who has missed the club's last four games with the injury, played in 122 games for the Twins this season, hitting .269 (103-for-383) with 23 doubles, one triple, 13 home runs, 48 RBI, 57 runs scored, 45 walks, a .352 on-base percentage and a .788 OPS...to replace Larnach on the 28-man roster, the Twins have recalled outfielder Alan Roden from Triple-A St. Paul...Roden has played in 48 games for the Saints this season, hitting .277 (53-for-191) with nine doubles, nine home runs, 32 RBI, 32 runs scored, 30 walks, a .387 on-base percentage and an .853 OPS...he played in 28 games for the Twins earlier this season from July 8-August 26, hitting .254 (17-for-67) with four doubles, 10 RBI, six runs scored, nine walks and a .333 on-base percentage.

RISPING IT ALL EARLY – A TALE OF TWO HALVES: The Twins led all of baseball in batting average, on-base percentage and were first in the American League and second in baseball (Philadelphia - .456) in slugging percentage with runners in scoring position prior to the All-Star break...since the break they rank 13th in the American League in batting average and on-base percentage and 12th in slugging...below is a comparison of their pre (through July 12) and post-All Star break (since July 16) numbers.

WALK(ER) IT LIKE I TALK IT: Last night, at 21 years and 210 days old, Walker Jenkins became the youngest Twin since Joe Mauer (July 3, 2004 at Arizona – 21 years and 75 days old) to collect three hits and one home run in the same game.

☞ Only four other players in Twins club history (1961-) have had a three-hit performance that included a home run prior to Jenkins' age: they are Zoilo Versalles (2x: 1961), Butch Wynegar (4x: 1976-77), Cristian Guzmán (1x: 1999) and Mauer (2x: 2004).

☞ Became the second-youngest player in all of baseball this season to record a three-hit, one home run performance; Pittsburgh's Konnor Griffen recorded three hits (two singles, one HR) on April 24 at Milwaukee on his 20th birthday.

☞ Jenkins' game-tying home run last night came off a 100.9 mph fastball from Ben Joyce; marked the second-fastest pitch a Twins player has homered off of in the Pitch Tracking Era (2008-), trailing only now-Angels manager Kurt Suzuki's homer on June 18, 2016 against New York-AL's Aroldis Chapman's 102.6 mph heater.

BLACK AND B-LUKE: Luke Keaschall ranks fifth in baseball in hit-by-pitches, trailing Iván Herrera (29), Sam Antonacci (27), Willson Contreras (24) and Randy Arozarena (23)...he has been hit by 21 pitches this season, tied with Willi Castro for the club record...below are the single-season all-time club leaders (since 1961):

BEFORE YOU LEAVE, PHONE, WALLET, KEAS: Over his last 48 road games since May 22 at Boston, Luke Keaschall is hitting .312 (54-for-173) with nine doubles, five home runs, 13 RBI, 29 runs scored, nine HBP, 18 walks, five stolen bases, a .405 on-base percentage and an .856 OPS...his .405 on-base percentage ranks first in the American League and seventh in baseball during that span, while his batting average ranks third in the AL and sixth in MLB.

NEW LEE-DER: Brooks Lee went 2-for-4 last night with two RBI and has now 81 on the season...now has 20-plus doubles (23), 20-plus home runs (23) and 80-plus RBI on the season, becoming only the fifth switch-hitting Twin to accomplish that feat in club history (1961-) and first to do so before turning 26...joins teammate Josh Bell (this season), Jorge Polanco (2021), Chili Davis (1991) and Roy Smalley (1979)...Smalley held the record for the youngest to do so prior to Lee, accomplishing the feat in his age-26 season.

TWINS, ANNUNCIATION AND WIFFLE BALL: Tomorrow (Saturday, September 19), the Twins and the Annunciation community will host a ribbon-cutting ceremony and inaugural wiffle ball games at Hope Field — the newly renovated and renamed wiffle ball field at Annunciation Church and School in Minneapolis...the ceremony will begin with opening remarks from 2:00-2:30 p.m. and conclude from 2:30-3:00 with wiffle ball games...the field was designed by HGA and constructed by Mortenson with on-site support from the Twins grounds crew; upgrades included grading, leveling and resodding the existing space, along with installing a new dirt infield, dugouts, bleachers, a moveable outfield fence, scoreboard and improved lighting, among other amenities...work began in June 2026 and was completed in September 2026.

Has a run value of three with his slider and a .222 BAA, both which rank second among Twins starters (Zebby Matthews: RV - 10 and BAA - .165)...Prielipp also leads all Twins with 574 sliders thrown this season.

Right-hander Joe Ryan is slated to toe the rubber for the 26th time this season in game three of a four-game series in Anaheim against the Angels...in his most recent start on September 13 vs. Cleveland, took his 10th loss of the season, allowing four runs on seven hits (2 HR), with one walk and a career-low-tying one strikeout in 4.0 innings pitched in the Twins 9-2 loss...the loss was Joe's fifth in a row, extending his career-long streak (previous high: two consecutive starts taking the loss, done seven times)...has made five starts against the Halos in his career, going 2-0 with a 3.10 ERA (29.0 IP, 10 ER), seven walks, 41 strikeouts, a .252 (.28-for-111) BAA and a 1.21 WHIP...started against the Angels on July 11 at Target Field; did not factor into the decision but made a quality start, firing 6.0 innings and allowing two runs on six hits, with two walks and six strikeouts in the Twins 5-3 win.
