THE TWINS: After completing their six-game homestand with a record of 2-4 (1-2 vs. Cleveland and 1-2 vs. New York-AL), the Twins began their final roadtrip of the season with split of the first two games in Anaheim...tonight, Minnesota will continue with the third of four games against the Angels through tomorrow...after tomorrow afternoon's game, they will head north to San Francisco for their final road series of the season, playing three against the Giants at Oracle Park from Monday-Wednesday.

☞ Twins have eight games remaining...after this roadtrip, they return home to finish the season with a three-game series vs. the Rangers from September 25-27.

☞ Twins are seeking consecutive wins for the first time since winning three-straight from August 30-September 1.

ROOKIE GLOW-UP IN ANAHEIM: The Twins shut out the Angels last night by a score of 3-0, Minnesota's fourth shutout of the season and first on the road since September 27, 2025 at Philadelphia (5-0)...Connor Prielipp (6-7) was the starter and winner, pitching 7.0 shutout innings (career high), with two hits allowed, two walks and eight strikeouts...the offense recorded nine hits, three from Walker Jenkins, who hit his second career home run in the seventh inning...Brooks Lee also recorded his second-straight two-hit game.

☞ Luke Keaschall was hit by his 22nd pitch this season, setting a single-season club record, passing Willi Castro (21 in 2024).

WHERE YA HEADED? ASPEN. MMM CALIFORNIA...BEAUTIFUL: The Twins and Angels are playing today for the sixth of seven games in 2026...Twins are 3-2 vs. the Angels this season, going 2-1 at Target Field in July and 1-1 this week in Anaheim.

☞ Minnesota has gone 15-7 in its last 22 against the Angels, dating back to May of 2023...in that span, have a run differential of +50 (132-82).

☞ Minnesota's .706 winning percentage (12-5) vs. the Angels since the start of 2024 is their highest against any MLB opponent.

☞ Notables vs. Angels pitching this season: Brooks Lee is 6-for-16 (.375) with two doubles, three RBI and three walks...Luke Keaschall is 5-for-16 (.313) with five singles...Walker Jenkins is 6-for-8 with two home runs and three RBI.

☞ In nine career games vs. LAA, Luke Keaschall is hitting .300 (9-for-30) with one double, three RBI, three hit-by-pitches, one stolen base and a .371 on-base percentage...he has reached base safely in eight of nine career games.

HEY EVERYONE! COME SEE HOW GOOD I LUKE!: Luke Keaschall has reached base safely in seven-straight games, hitting .407 (11-for-27) with three walks and a .484 on-base percentage in that span...since moving to the leadoff spot on August 17, Keaschall is slashing .322/.405/.435 (.839 OPS) in 29 games...additionally, below are Keaschall's offensive comparisons from the start of the season through June and since July 1:

THE LEFTORIUM: Twins are facing a left-handed starter for the fourth time in their last nine games (previous 3: Parker Messick - loss on 9/11, Max Fried - loss on 9/15, Carlos Rodón - win on 9/16)...notable numbers vs. left-handed pitching:

☞ Since August 6, Luke Keaschall is hitting .356 (21-for-59) vs. lefties, with five doubles, a .397 on-base percentage and an .838 OPS.

☞ Since August 6, Josh Bell is hitting .321 (17-for-53) with an .893 OPS vs. lefties.

CAPTAIN AMERICA, HOLLYWOOD STORY: Walker Jenkins has six hits in eight at-bats this series, including two home runs, three RBI and just one strikeout...below are his first 16 career games (August 28-September 16), compared to his last two games:

WE'RE TALKIN' LEE: Over his last 13 road games, Brooks Lee is hitting .314 (16-for-51) with four doubles, four home runs, seven RBI, a .627 slugging percentage, and a .948 OPS.

☞ Lee has 23 home runs, ranking third on the Twins, trailing Kody Clemens (26) and Byron Buxton (25)...his 23 HR are third most in baseball among switch hitters, trailing Elly De La Cruz (28) and Ian Happ (24).

☞ Lee's 23 homers are tied with Carlos Santana (2024) for fourth-most by a switch hitter in Twins history (since 1961), trailing Jorge Polanco (33 in 2021), Chili Davis (29 in 1991) and Roy Smalley (24 in 1979).

☞ Lee has 20 homers as a left-handed batter and three as a right-handed batter...the three vs. lefties were: April 10 at Toronto off Patrick Corbin, April 11 at Toronto off Eric Lauer and May 25 at Chicago-AL off Anthony Kay.

SOLID 'PENMANSHIP: Over their last four games, the Twins bullpen has posted a 2.40 ERA (15.0 IP, 4 ER) with eight walks, 19 strikeouts (11.4 K/9.0 IP) and just one home run allowed.

DON'T HASSLE THE HOFF: Jeff Hoffman enters tonight having thrown 8.1 scoreless innings since August 26...since being acquired by the Twins at the deadline, 15 of his 18 appearances have been scoreless, posting a 2.25 ERA (16.0 IP, 4 ER) with 25 strikeouts and a .161 opponent batting average.

☞ With 69 appearances this season (51 for Toronto & 18 for Minnesota), Hoffman has the second-most appearances of his career (71 for Toronto in 2025).

☞ His 100 strikeouts on the season are already a single-season career-high (previous high was 89 for Philadelphia in 2024)...on Thursday night, he became the first AL reliever to reach the 100-strikeout mark...he is one of five relievers in baseball with 100-plus strikeouts, joining Mason Miller (119), Aaron Ashby (107), Adrian Morejon (101) and Cade Smith (100).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: On this day in 2019, the Twins beat the Royals by a score of 8-5 and improved to 94-59 on the season...the 94 wins made Rocco Baldelli the fifth rookie manager in Twins/Senators franchise history (1901-) to reach that mark...Ron Gardenhire went 94-67 in 2002, Billy Martin went 97-65 in 1969, Bill Rigney went 98-64 in 1970 and Joe Cronin went 99-53 in 1933...in 2020, the Twins clinched a playoff berth with an 8-1 victory over the Cubs...they went on to win the American League Central on the season's final day, then were swept in two games by Houston in the American League Wild Card Series.
