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THE TWINS: After completing their six-game homestand with a record of 3-3 (1-2 vs. Chicago-AL and 2-1 vs. Detroit), the Twins began their six-game roadtrip with a loss in Chicago last night...tonight, Minnesota will continue the trip with the second of three against the White Sox at Rate Field...after tomorrow night's series finale, they will travel to Detroit to play the Tigers for three games at Comerica Park, from Monday-Wednesday.

☞ The Twins have 21 games remaining, nine against AL Central opponents — two vs. the White Sox, three vs. the Tigers and three vs. the Guardians...they also play the Angels (.376 win%), Giants (.408 win%) and Rangers (.493 win%)...their remaining opponents have a combined winning percentage of .469, the fifth-lowest strength of schedule in baseball.
☞ Twins have 12 road games remaining and nine home games.

ERICK FEDDE....AGAIN....: The Twins lost to the White Sox last night at Rate Field by a score of 4-1...Zebby Matthews (9-9) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing four runs on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched...he allowed a career-high-tying three home runs, which accounted for all of his runs allowed...the offense recorded eight hits, three from Kody Clemens, and two apiece from Josh Bell and Royce Lewis...the offense was shut out until Bell's 18th home run of the season in the ninth inning — a 460-foot shot, the longest home run by a Twin in 2026.

CHI-LIGHTS: The Twins and White Sox are playing the 12th of 13 games this season...Twins are 4-7 vs. the Sox in 2026, going 3-3 at Target Field and 1-4 at Rate Field.

☞ Minnesota has gone 28-17 in its last 45 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023...that includes a road record of 13-9 at Rate Field.

☞ Luke Keaschall is hitting .348 (24-for-69) with five doubles, nine walks, five stolen bases, a .432 on-base percentage and an .896 OPS in 19 career games against the Sox...he has reached base safely in all 18 games...he has hit safely in all six career games at Rate Field.

☞ In 17 career games vs. Chicago-AL, Royce Lewis is hitting .344 (22-for-64) with seven home runs, 21 RBI, a .703 slugging percentage and a 1.136 OPS...in eight career games at Rate Field, he is hitting .400 (12-for-30) with four home runs, 12 RBI, six walks, a .500 on-base percentage, an .833 slugging percentage and a 1.333 OPS...he has homered four times in eight games here, including two grand slams.

☞ Since the start of 2023, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .324 (34-for-105) with an .896 OPS in 32 games vs. the White Sox.

BELL POWER: With his ninth-inning solo home run last night, Josh Bell drove in one more run, giving him a team-leading 84 on the season...it's the fourth-most of his career (116 in 2019, 90 in 2017 and 88 in 2021).

☞ 84 RBI rank tied for fifth-best in the AL and tied for 12th-most in baseball.

☞ Bell is on pace for 96 RBI, which would be the most for a Twin since Jorge Polanco drove in 98 in 2021.

☞ Since August 17, he has 12 RBI in 15 games.

☞ Bell's 460-foot home run last night is tied for the fourth-longest of his career...his three longer were: 474 feet (2019), 472 feet (2019) and 464 feet (2023).

FIRE CODE: Over his last 17 games, Kody Clemens is hitting .328 (20-for-61) with one double, one triple, four home runs, 14 RBI, a .574 slugging percentage and a .965 OPS.

☞ Clemens is one home run away from tying Byron Buxton (25) for the club lead in homers.

☞ Since June 16, Clemens has 45 RBI, fourth-most in the AL, trailing Junior Caminero (58), Jac Caglianone (49) and Pete Alonso (46).

LEFT TURNS: Tonight marks the 44th lefty starter the Twins will be facing this season, going 20-23 in previous games.

☞ Since July 5, 2025, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .336 (48-for-143) with a .455 on-base percentage and a .930 OPS vs. left-handed pitching...since that date, he leads the AL in on-base percentage (min. 150 PA), ranks third in batting average and seventh in OPS.

☞ Since July 31, Royce Lewis is hitting .361 (13-for-36) vs. lefties, with two doubles, two home runs and a .944 OPS.

☞ Since August 6, Luke Keaschall is hitting .361 (13-for-36) vs. lefties, with five doubles, a .425 on-base percentage and a .925 OPS.

☞ Kody Clemens has a .433 slugging percentage vs. lefties this season, the 10th-best in the AL among left-handed hitters.

☞ Kaelen Culpepper is hitting .323 (10-for-31) with an .837 OPS vs. lefties this season.

ROYCE RULES: Over his last three games, Royce Lewis has gone 6-for-14 (.429) with one walk, two doubles, one home run and five RBI...at 51 RBI on the season, he needs one more to match his single-season career-high of 52, done in 2023 and 2025.

☞ Over his last 15 road games, Lewis is hitting .305 (18-for-59) with five doubles, two home runs, eight RBI and an .803 OPS.

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: Twins need wins tonight and tomorrow night to earn their 22nd series victory...they have gone 21-22-2 in series play, 14-8-1 at home and 7-14-1 on the road.
☞ Twins are 1-2-0 in series play vs. the Sox this season, their only win coming June 1-3.

☞ Twins began the season going 8-13-1 in their first 22 series through June 11, but have gone 13-9-1 in their last 23 series overall, dating back to June 12-14 vs. St. Louis.

☞ Minnesota's last road series win was July 3-5 at New York-AL.

RED HOT KAELEN PEPPERS: Kaelen Culpepper has hit safely in 18 of 23 games to start his career...over his last 10 games, he is hitting .316 (12-for-38) with three doubles, one home run, six RBI, four walks, a .381 on-base percentage and an .855 OPS.

☞ In nine road games to start his career, he is slashing .333/.429/.667 (1.095 OPS)...he has hit safely in six-straight away from Target Field.

TY GAME: Minor League Baseball recently announced their monthly award winners for August...Double-A Wichita right-hander Ty Langenberg was the Texas League Pitcher of the Month...he went 1-0 with a 1.00 ERA in six appearances (5 starts) as he allowed three earned runs on 10 hits with eight walks and 21 strikeouts in 27.0 innings...he led the TL in ERA (1.00), batting average against (.115) and hits-per-9.0 (3.39)...he was second in WHIP (0.67) and began the month with a streak of 16 consecutive scoreless innings.

FLORIDA MEN: The Twins, in conjunction with Major League Baseball, yesterday announced their home schedule for spring training in 2027...Twins will open their schedule on February 19 against Tampa Bay...the Twins host the Mets in Fort Myers for the first time since March 2014 on March 3...Minnesota also travels to Port St. Lucie for the first time in 13 years, playing the Mets there on March 13...the Twins welcome the Red Sox on February 26 and again on Thursday, March 18 as part of the annual Fort Myers "Chairman's Cup" series...they will also play two against the Rays, Orioles and Braves, and one game against the Phillies, Blue Jays, Pirates, Nationals, Tigers and Yankees.
