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THE TWINS: Began their six-game roadtrip with a 1-1 split at Rate Field, dropping game one on Friday night but winning game two last night...tonight, Minnesota will continue the trip with the three-game series finale in Chicago...after tonight's game, they will travel to Detroit to play the Tigers for three games at Comerica Park, from Monday-Wednesday.
❖ Minnesota's remaining opponents have a combined winning percentage of .467, the fourth-lowest strength of schedule in baseball.
❖ Twins have gone 13-10 in rubber games this season...they are 9-5 in their last 14 rubber game chances...their last rubber game was a loss on August 26 at the Athletics and their last win was on August 12 vs. Baltimore.

BIG WIN-DY CITY VICTORY: The Twins beat the White Sox last night on the South Side by a score of 6-4, their 31st come-from-behind victory this season...Taj Bradley (11-6) was the starter and winner, allowing four runs on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched; three of his runs allowed coming in the first inning...Kody Funderburk (1.0), Jeff Hoffman (1.1), A.J. Minter (0.2) and Yoendrys Gómez (1.0) combined to pitch 4.0 scoreless innings of relief...the offense recorded eight hits as the top four hitters in the Twins lineup combined to go 7-for-18 with six runs scored and four RBI...Ryan Jeffers hit the go-ahead three-run homer in the fifth inning.

CHI-LIGHTS: The Twins and White Sox are playing for the 13th and final time this season...Twins are 5-7 vs. the Sox in 2026, going 3-3 at Target Field and 2-4 at Rate Field.
❖ These two will meet next from June 10-13, 2027 for four games at Target Field...Twins will be back in this ballpark for three games from June 18-20, 2027.
❖ Minnesota has gone 29-17 in its last 46 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023...that includes a record of 14-9 at Rate Field.
❖ Luke Keaschall is hitting .351 (26-for-74) with five doubles, nine walks, five stolen bases, a .430 on-base percentage and an .890 OPS in 20 career games against the Sox...he has reached base safely in 19 of 20 games.
❖ In 18 career games vs. Chicago-AL, Royce Lewis is hitting .328 (22-for-67) with seven home runs, 21 RBI, a .672 slugging percentage and a 1.095 OPS...in nine career games at Rate Field, he is hitting .364 (12-for-33) with four home runs, 12 RBI, seven walks, a .475 on-base percentage, a .758 slugging percentage and a 1.233 OPS...he has homered four times in nine games here, including two grand slams.
❖ Since the start of 2023, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .321 (35-for-109) with six doubles, four home runs, 14 RBI, 15 walks, a .405 on-base percentage and a .909 OPS in 33 games vs. the White Sox.

LUKE WHO KEEPS HITTING: Luke Keaschall has 15 multi-hit games in his last 31 games overall (48%)...in that span, he is hitting .333 (40-for-120) with a .955 OPS...below are Keaschall's offensive comparisons through June and since July 1:

KEA CONTRIBUTOR: Since being inserted into the leadoff spot on August 17, Keaschall has led off in all 17 Twins games and has hit .329 (24-for-73) with an .881 OPS, reaching safely in 15 of the 17...since August 17, he leads all leadoff hitters in batting average and hits.

EVERYTHING'S OKAE: Kaelen Culpepper has hit safely in 19 of 24 games to start his career...over his last 11 games, he is hitting .326 (14-for-43) with four doubles, one home run, seven RBI, four walks, a .383 on-base percentage and an .871 OPS.
❖ In 10 road games to start his career, he is slashing .343/.425/.657 (1.082 OPS)...he has hit safely in seven-straight away from Target Field.

ANSWERING THE BELL: Josh Bell enters tonight with a team-leading 84 RBI and has driven in 12 runs in his last 16 games.
❖ 84 RBI rank tied for sixth-best in the AL and tied for 14th-most in baseball.
❖ 84 are the fourth-most of his career (116 in 2019, 90 in 2017 and 88 in 2021).
❖ He is on pace for 95 RBI, which would be the most for a Twin since Jorge Polanco drove in 98 in 2021.
❖ Since June 14, he is slashing .313/.381/.588 (.969 OPS) in 34 road games, the highest OPS in baseball (chart in right margin)...in that span, he has nine doubles, nine home runs and 28 RBI in 34 games.

MASTER JEFF: Ryan Jeffers hit his 14th home run of the season last night, tied for the second-most of his career in a single season (14 in 2021 and 14 in '23); his career-high is 21 in 2024...over his last six games, he is hitting .292 (7-for-24) with two doubles, one triple, four home runs, 11 RBI, two walks, a .346 on-base percentage, a .958 slugging percentage and a 1.304 OPS.

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: Twins need a win tonight to earn their 22nd series victory...they have gone 21-22-2 in series play, 14-8-1 at home and 7-14-1 on the road.
❖ Twins are 1-2-0 in series play vs. the Sox this season, their only win coming June 1-3.
❖ Twins began the season going 8-13-1 in their first 22 series through June 11, but have gone 13-9-1 in their last 23 series overall, dating back to June 12-14 vs. St. Louis.
❖ Minnesota's last road series win was July 3-5 at New York-AL.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: The Twins have named Triple-A St. Paul outfielder Emmanuel Rodriguez and High-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher Reed Moring as their minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.
❖ Rodriguez, 23, played in six games for the Saints, hitting .280 (7-for-25) with one double, one triple, one home run, four RBI and five walks, including hitting for the cycle on Tuesday at Omaha...the Santo Domingo, DR native is currently ranked as the clubs' fifth-best prospect by MiLB.com.
❖ Moring, 22, made the start on Thursday at South Bend, allowing two runs on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and seven strikeouts...the Santa Cruz, CA native was drafted by the Twins in the 15th round of the 2025 MLB draft out of the University of California, Santa Barbara.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2002, Brad Radke pitched the Twins to a 6-0 victory at the Metrodome, beating the A's and snapping Oakland's 20-game win streak...Radke pitched a complete-game shutout with six hits allowed and one walk...in 2016, The Twins lost 10-3 to the Royals at Target Field, but Brian Dozier homered in his fifth-straight game, tying a team record, giving him 39 on the season and tying the American League record for a second baseman set by Alfonso Soriano (2003).
