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THE TWINS: Began their six-game roadtrip with a 1-2 series defeat at Rate Field in Chicago, winning just the middle game on Saturday...this afternoon, Minnesota will continue the trip with the first of three games against the Tigers at Comerica Park...they will complete the series and trip on Wednesday afternoon.

✎ Minnesota's remaining opponents have a combined winning percentage of .463, the second-lowest strength of schedule in baseball.

NO PEACOCKING FOR TWINS ON SUNDAY NIGHT: The Twins lost to the White Sox at Rate Field last night by a score of 10-1...Bailey Ober (7-5) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing one run on four hits in 4.1 innings pitched, with three walks and six strikeouts...the bullpen combined to allow nine runs in 3.2 innings pitched...the offense recorded four hits, walked once and struck out 15 times - their most punch outs since August 9 at Milwaukee (also 15)...Brooks Lee had two of the club's four hits, one being a solo home run in the seventh inning, his 23rd of the season.

WELCOME, EXPERIENCE: The Twins have returned right-handed pitcher Joe Ryan from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 15-day Injured List...the 2026 AL All-Star, who was placed on the Injured List on August 7 with a left glute strain, made one start on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul on September 1 at Omaha, allowing one run on one hit (a solo homer) in 3.0 innings pitched, with no walks, four strikeouts and 42 pitches thrown.

✎ To make room for Ryan on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Garrett Acton to St. Paul...Acton made three appearances on his most recent stint with the Twins, allowing five runs on six hits in 4.1 innings pitched, with three walks and five strikeouts.

TIGER THINGS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the 11th of 13 games today...Twins are 7-3 vs. the Tigers this season, going 6-1 at Target Field and 1-2 at Comerica Park.

✎ These two met last week as the Twins took the first two games by outscoring the Tigers 26-3...Minnesota went for the sweep but lost the finale by a score of 11-6 in 12 innings.

✎ Twins lead baseball in home runs vs. Detroit since the start of 2019, hitting 165, 38 ahead of Cleveland (127)...76 of those have come at Comerica Park...they have homered 36 times in their last 23 games at Comerica and 14 times in their last six here.

✎ Luke Keaschall is hitting .364 (20-for-55) with four doubles, two home runs, 14 RBI, seven walks, a .462 on-base percentage and a 1.007 OPS in 15 career games vs. Detroit...in four career games at Comerica, he is 7-for-15 with two doubles, one home run and six RBI.

✎ In 30 career games vs. Detroit, Royce Lewis is hitting .300 (30-for-100) with five doubles, five home runs, 20 RBI, 20 walks, a .413 on-base percentage, a .500 slugging percentage and a .913 OPS...he has reached base safely in all 30 career games...lifetime at Comerica, he is slashing .318/.388/.568 (.956 OPS) in 12 games.

✎ Notables this season vs. Detroit: Josh Bell is 14-for-39 (.359) with one double, two home runs, five RBI and four walks...Royce Lewis is 13-for-37 (.351) with two doubles, two home runs, nine RBI and seven walks...Luke Keaschall is 11-for-32 (.344) with two doubles, one home run, seven RBI and four walks...Ryan Jeffers is 7-for-20 (.350) with two doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI and three walks.

HANGING NUMBERS: The Twins enter today with 666 runs scored this season, second-most in the AL, trailing only Chicago-AL (680)...Minnesota scored 4.87 runs-per-game pre-All-Star break, which ranked first in the AL...but since the break, they have scored 4.24 runs-per-game, eighth-most in the AL.

COOL HANDS LUKE: Luke Keaschall has 15 multi-hit games in his last 32 games overall (47%)...in that span, he is hitting .325 (40-for-123) with a .933 OPS...below are Keaschall's offensive comparisons through June and since July 1:

JOGGING OR YOGGING, IT MIGHT BE A SOFT J: Over their last 40 games, since July 23, the Twins have stolen 24 bases in 30 attempts for a 80.0% success rate...since that date, their stolen base percentage ranks fourth-highest in the AL, trailing Toronto (85.3%), Los Angeles-AL (83.9%) and Kansas City (82.9%).

I'M A BE-LEE-VER: Brooks Lee hit his 23rd home run last night and ranks third on the Twins, trailing Byron Buxton (25) and Kody Clemens (24)...his 23 HR are also tied with Chicago-NL's Ian Happ and Cincinnati's Elly De La Cruz for most among all switch hitters this season...over his last 25 games, Lee is hitting .300 (30-for-100) with five doubles, seven home runs, 19 RBI, one walk, a .311 on-base percentage, a .560 slugging percentage and an .871 OPS...additionally, he has just 14 strikeouts in 103 plate appearances (13.6%) in that span.

ROYCE RULES: Over his last five games, Royce Lewis has gone 7-for-20 (.350) with two walks, two doubles, one home run and five RBI.

✎ At 51 RBI on the season, he needs one more to match his single-season career-high of 52, done in 2023 and 2025...he has already set career-highs in games (108), hits (94), doubles (22), walks (37) and stolen bases (14).

✎ Over his last 16 road games, Lewis is hitting .295 (18-for-61) with four doubles, two home runs, eight RBI and a .772 OPS.

TWINS MiLB MONTHLYS: The Twins recently named outfielder Walker Jenkins and Double-A Wichita right-handed pitcher Adrian Bohorquez as their minor league Player and Pitcher of the Month for August.

✎ Jenkins, who had his contract selected by Minnesota on August 28, played in 18 games for Triple-A St. Paul last month, hitting .411 (30-for-73) with two doubles, one triple, eight home runs, 13 RBI, 11 walks, a .488 on-base percentage, a .795 slugging percentage and a 1.283 OPS.

✎ Bohorquez, 21, appeared in four games (3 starts) for Wichita and High-A Cedar Rapids last month, going 1-1, 0.45 ERA (20.0 IP, 1 ER) with seven walks, 24 strikeouts and a 0.80 WHIP...the La Victoria, Venezuela native was signed by the Twins as an international free agent in January of 2023.

CLOCKING IN ON LABOR DAY: The Twins are 45-27 on Labor Day since 1961, including a 21-13 record at home and 24-14 record on the road...the Twins have won five of their last seven Labor Day games and are 8-5 in their last 13...last season, they lost to the White Sox at Target Field by a score of 6-5.
