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**THE TWINS:** Have gone 1-3 through four games on their six-game roadtrip, losing a series 1-2 in Chicago against the White Sox over the weekend, followed by a loss in Detroit yesterday afternoon...tonight, Minnesota will continue the trip with the second of three games against the Tigers at Comerica Park...they will complete the series and trip tomorrow afternoon, then travel back to Minneapolis...they will enjoy an off-day on Thursday, then host the Guardians for three games over the weekend, followed by the Yankees for three games from Monday-Wednesday.   
✦ Twins have 18 games remaining, nine road games and nine home games.   
✦ Minnesota's remaining opponents have a combined winning percentage of .464, the third-lowest strength of schedule in baseball.

**TIGERS OUTWORK TWINS ON LABOR DAY:** The Twins lost to the Tigers on Monday afternoon by a score of 5-4, making the Twins 14-21 in one-run games this season...Joe Ryan (6-9) made his return from the IL (left glute strain), allowing three runs (2 earned) on three hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with one walk and seven strikeouts...Connor Prielipp piggy-backed Ryan and made his second career relief appearance, allowing two runs on five hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with no walks and five strikeouts...the offense recorded eight hits and walked six times...Trevor Larnach led the group by going 2-for-4 with his 12th home run of the season...Walker Jenkins went 1-for-3, was hit by a pitch and drove in two runs.

**MOTOWN SHOWDOWN:** The Twins and Tigers are playing the 12th of 13 games today...Twins are 7-4 vs. the Tigers this season, going 6-1 at Target Field and 1-3 at Comerica Park.   
✦ Twins are looking to avoid losing three-straight to the Tigers for the first time since August 14-16, 2025 (also 3).   
✦ Twins lead baseball in home runs vs. Detroit since the start of 2019, hitting 166, 39 ahead of Cleveland (127)...77 of those have come at Comerica Park...they have homered 37 times in their last 24 games at Comerica and 15 times in their last seven here.   
✦ Luke Keaschall is hitting .368 (21-for-57) with four doubles, two home runs, 14 RBI, nine walks, a .486 on-base percentage and a 1.030 OPS in 16 career games vs. Detroit...in five career games at Comerica, Keaschall has posted a .591 on-base percentage (8 hits, 3 walks in 22 plate appearances).   
✦ In 31 career games vs. Detroit, Royce Lewis is hitting .288 (30-for-104) with five doubles, five home runs, 20 RBI, 20 walks, a .400 on-base percentage, a .481 slugging percentage and an .881 OPS...yesterday's 0-for-4 snapped his on-base streak vs. the Tigers at 30 games...lifetime at Comerica, he is slashing .292/.358/.521 (.879 OPS) in 13 games.   
✦ Notables this season vs. Detroit: Josh Bell is 14-for-43 (.326) with one double, two home runs, five RBI and five walks...Royce Lewis is 13-for-41 (.317) with two doubles, two home runs, nine RBI and seven walks...Luke Keaschall is 12-for-34 (.353) with two doubles, one home run, seven RBI and six walks...Trevor Larnach is 8-for-26 (.308) with one double, one home run two RBI and two walks.

**SCORING POINTS:** The Twins enter today with 670 runs scored this season, second-most in the AL, trailing only Chicago-AL (680)...Minnesota scored 4.87 runs-per-game before the All-Star break, which ranked first in the AL...but since the break, they have scored 4.23 runs-per-game, eighth-most in the AL.

**RED HOT KEASCHALL SUMMER:** Luke Keaschall has 15 multi-hit games in his last 33 games overall (45%) since July 31...in that span, he is hitting .328 (41-for-125) with a .946 OPS...below are Keaschall's offensive comparisons through June and since July 1:

**RUB SOME ROBITUSSIN ON IT:** Luke Keaschall was hit by pitch again yesterday in the first inning, his 20th hit-by-pitch this season, one short of the single-season club record of 21, set by Willi Castro in 2024...he ranks fifth in baseball in hit-by-pitches this season...below are the all-time club leaders (since 1961):

**ADDITIONALLY...** Keaschall ranks fifth in baseball in HBP, trailing Iván Herrera (27), Sam Antonacci (25), Randy Arozarena (22) and Willson Contreras (22).

**FEELS LIKE YOU'RE RUNNING AT AN INCREDIBLE RATE:** Twins successfully stole two more bases yesterday (Keaschall & Lee)...Over their last 41 games, since July 23, the Twins have stolen 26 bases in 32 attempts for an 81.3% success rate...since that date, their stolen base percentage ranks fourth-highest in the AL, trailing Los Angeles-AL (84.4%), Kansas City (83.3%) and Toronto (82.9%).

**WE'RE TALKIN' LEE:** Over his last 26 games, Lee is hitting .298 (31-for-104) with five doubles, seven home runs, 19 RBI, two walks, a .315 on-base percentage, a .548 slugging percentage and an .863 OPS...additionally, he has just 14 strikeouts in 108 plate appearances (13.0%) in that span.   
✦ Brooks Lee hit his 23rd home run on Sunday night and ranks third on the Twins, trailing Byron Buxton (25) and Kody Clemens (24)...his 23 HR are also tied with Ian Happ for second-most by a switch hitter in all of baseball, trailing Elly De La Cruz (24).   
✦ Lee's 23 homers are tied with Carlos Santana (2024) for fourth-most by a switch hitter in Twins history (since 1961), trailing Jorge Polanco (33 in 2021), Chili Davis (29 in 1991) and Roy Smalley (24 in 1979).   
✦ Lee has 20 homers as a left-handed batter and three as a right-handed batter.

**SERIES ISSUES:** Twins need wins tonight and tomorrow to earn their 22nd series victory...they have gone 21-23-2 in series play, 14-8-1 at home and 7-15-1 on the road.   
✦ Twins are 2-1-0 in series play vs. the Tigers this season.   
✦ Twins began the season going 8-13-1 in their first 22 series through June 11, but have gone 13-10-1 in their last 24 series overall, dating back to June 12-14 vs. St. Louis.   
✦ Minnesota's last road series win was July 3-5 at New York-AL.

**ON THIS DAY IN PAUL MOLITOR HISTORY:** On this day in 1998, Paul Molitor hit the penultimate home run of his career off Allen Watson, a two-out solo shot in the seventh inning, en route to a 5-0 Twins victory over the Angels in Anaheim...Mollie's final homer came on September 19 of that season, at Detroit, off Frank Castillo...the homer against the Angels was his one hit that day and extended his hitting streak to nine games, eventually finishing the streak at 17 games.
